

Breakfast, Lunch, Milk Prices 2021-22

The U.S. Department of Agriculture will continue reimbursing schools and childcare centers for free meals to all students regardless of their income through the 2021-22 school year, USDA officials announced on April 20, 2021. To read the full press release from the USDA, click [HERE](#).

All school meals served by the School District of Wisconsin Dells will be free for students for the 2021-22 school year.

Exceptions:

- A la carte items will be available for purchase at the high school and middle school. Students must have funds in their account to cover any a la carte purchases. This includes an EXTRA meal or SINGLE milk taken during breakfast and/or lunch.
- The District will participate in the Wisconsin School Day Milk Program during the 2021-22 school year. The program is for 4K through fifth grade students. Students who are eligible for free or reduced-price meal benefits qualify for FREE milk at milk break. Students who participate that are PAID status will be charged \$8 per month for milk at the beginning of each month. **Your child(ren) will not receive milk at milk break if there is not enough money in their account to cover the monthly milk charge.**
