### Child Care Assistance (known as Wisconsin SHARE)

Located at Marquette County Economic Support, 428 Underwood Avenue, Montello. Pays for some of the childcare costs for families with limited income, including regulated after-school programs. You may qualify if you have a child under 13 or a child with special needs under 18. You need to be either working and going to school, or in job training. Options:

3. Go to Economic Support office, 428 Underwood Avenue, Montello, complete brief paperwork, and schedule appointment with a worker within 7 days.
