Goal #2

By the start of the summer of 2016, the School District of Wisconsin Dells will increase the number of course offerings in our comprehensive summer school program to meet the needs of all learners. The two primary areas will be to continue to focus on developing literacy and mathematical skills.

- A Summer School Interest Survey will be posted in November (2014) to parents in current grades Kindergarten through 5th grade. **(MET)**
- Area summer school programs have been reviewed for an initial program framework. **(MET)**
- School and community representatives will collaborate about the summer school program and how to effectively launch it in summer 2015. **(MET)**
- Seek approval from Board of Education to start elementary summer school program July 1, 2015. **(MET)**
- **2015-16 – investigate expansion to additional grade levels.**
- **2015-16 – review area summer school programs for additional enrichment opportunities.**
