E. CONSENT AGENDA - Motion and vote on recommendations

DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT

E.1. RECOMMENDATION: Approve routine field trips.

RATIONALE:

Board Policy 3314 requires that all out-of-state student field/study trips and travel have prior authorization by the Board of Education.

E.2. RECOMMENDATION:

Amend item E.14 on the June 6, 2022 agreement with Tulsa Officials of Oklahoma Association, a 501 (c)(3).

FURTHER RECOMMEND:

The attorneys for the school district prepare/approve the appropriate contract document(s) and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute the document(s) on behalf of the district.

COST:

This is an increase of \$8,000. Total cost not to exceed \$84,000.

FUND NAME/ACCOUNT: 11-0000-2199-503430-000-000000-000-16-068-

REQUISITION/CONTRACT: 12307467

RATIONALE:

The amendment agreement is due to the increase in games allowing more students the opportunity to participate in athletic competitions. It will allow the district to pay officials in a timely manner by making one payment each month to the Tulsa Officials of Oklahoma Association. The Tulsa Officials of Oklahoma Association will handle all payroll considerations, which currently are being processed through the district. The agreement will streamline the district's ability to pay officials in an efficient manner and will greatly reduce the amount of work by school personnel.

TEACHING AND LEARNING

E.3. RECOMMENDATION:

Enter into an agreement with Go Power Schools, LLC, to accept grant funds in the amount of \$61,200 for Yale National Initiative during the 2022-2023 school year.

FURTHER RECOMMEND:

The attorneys for the school district prepare/approve the appropriate contract document(s) and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute the document(s) on behalf of the district.

RATIONALE:

The Teacher Institute for Tulsa will be sustained by the Yale National Initiative through information sessions, site visits, annual conferences, and national seminars. National seminars have the twin purposes of providing teachers first-hand experience with the Teacher Institute approach, while affording them an opportunity to increase their preparation in a subject they teach and to develop a curriculum unit to teach what they have learned to their own students. There is an annual cycle of events through which

Yale National Initiative provides opportunities that are coordinated with the Tulsa Teacher Institute. In April, Tulsa Public Schools teachers who are selected to participate in one of the national seminars attend an Organizational Session. In July, when the teachers return for the Intensive Session, they are joined by University of Tulsa faculty members, who observe national seminars and attend meetings on the Teachers Institute approach. In October, Tulsa Public Schools teachers, together with their superintendent, convene for the Annual Conference.

TALENT MANAGEMENT

E.4. RECOMMENDATION: Approve routine staffing items.

RATIONALE:

Routine personnel actions implement the various talent management plans and priorities authorized by the Board of Education. All salaries are listed at an effective annualized rate regardless of length of effective date of contract.

E.5. RECOMMENDATION:

Enter into an agreement with Idemia Identity and Security USA LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, and global leader in trusted identities, to purchase the Universal Enrollment Platform (UEP) Enroll Your Own (EYO) Enrollment Workstations consisting of digital fingerprinting devices and related equipment, software, and services.

FURTHER RECOMMEND:

The attorneys for the school district prepare/approve the appropriate contract document(s) and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute the document(s) on behalf of the district.

COST:

Not to exceed \$45,000

FUND NAME/ACCOUNT: IT 2015 bond project 1173

REQUISITION/CONTRACT:

RATIONALE:

It is an essential function of the district to keep our students safe and to ensure the continuity of our hiring and onboarding initiative. Idemia Identity and Security holds a contract with the Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE) to provide all background and teacher certification checks for newly hired employees and current employees. This agreement will allow Tulsa Public Schools to purchase fingerprinting stations in order to collect and submit fingerprints and biographic information quickly while helping to streamline the hiring process for employees. Eliminating steps in the hiring process will reduce the number of weeks of processing to fulfill critical vacancies across the district. Idemia is the only vendor authorized to provide these services in Oklahoma.

E.6. RECOMMENDATION:

Enter into an agreement with Zipstorm, Inc., dba, Seek Out, to provide a tool that increases access to potential candidates for teachers, support professionals and school leaders from March 2023 through March 2024.

FURTHER RECOMMEND: The attorneys for the school district prepare/approve the appropriate contract document(s) and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute the document(s) on behalf of the district.

COST: Not to exceed \$20,000

FUND NAME/ACCOUNT: 81-2254-503370-000-000000-000-04-041

REQUISITION/CONTRACT: 12307773

RATIONALE:

Recruiting teachers, support professionals, and school leaders is critical for the success of the district. Passively posting jobs and relying on candidates to find them and apply is an insufficient strategy for filling the roles that the Talent Management team anticipates for the coming school year. This recruitment tool provides broader, more direct access to candidates nation-wide as well as higher quality search options and analytics as compared to others of comparable price.

FINANCIAL SERVICES

E.7. RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the New Encumbrance & Change Order Report February 24, 2023 through March 2, 2023.

RATIONALE:

New encumbrances and encumbrance changes reflect obligations of district funds issued in accordance with Board Policy 5102, Financial Reports and Statements.

E.8. RECOMMENDATION:

Amend the contract for the lease with the Hight Point Youth Ranch, Inc. of the district's Ropes Course at Lowell to reflect a two-year term, beginning March 1, 2023 until March 1, 2025.

FURTHER RECOMMEND:

The attorneys for the school district prepare/approve the appropriate contract document(s) and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute the document(s) on behalf of the district.

COST:

There is no cost to the lessee for this facility. The lessee will be responsible for all utilities, custodial and grounds and course certification. TPS will have free admission for one grade level of students with a certified instructor.

RATIONALE:

The existing facility has not been used within the last two years. The new entity provides new course certification and access for TPS students to use the course.

E.9. RECOMMENDATION: Approve the license agreement by Humble Sons Bike Co., a 501(c)(3) for the limited purpose of constructing a series of hiking, bicycling and educational trails located on the 12 acres of wooded property adjacent to Whitman Elementary.

FURTHER RECOMMEND: The attorneys for the school district prepare/approve the appropriate contract document(s) and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute the document(s) on behalf of the district.

COST: There is no cost to the district.

RATIONALE: This project will be tendered to TPS as a charitable donation. The licensor's acceptance of the donation shall be evidenced by the execution and delivery of a Certificate of Acceptance.

E.10. RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the purchase of two Model C Electric buses from The Lion Electric Company Corp.

COST: There is no cost to the district.

RATIONALE:

The district was awarded a grant from the EPA School Bus Rebate Program. The grant amount is equivalent to \$750k, which is being paid from the EPA School Bus Rebate program and will be paid directly to The Lion Electric Company Corp. which is the vendor providing the electric buses. The buses are scheduled to be delivered in the summer of 2023. In order to receive the buses, the board needs to authorize.

OPERATIONS

E.11. RECOMMENDATION: Approve the April 1, 2023, capacity data for out of district transfers to comport with requirements of Senate Bill 783.

RATIONALE: Senate Bill 783 requires each school district to determine the criteria to be used in determining grade capacity for each school site. Each school site's capacity shall be approved the board of education prior to the first day of January, April, July and October of each school year.
