WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS?



DUAL ENROLLMENT

This online program is for students who wish to remain on Wright City High School campus and complete one or more college level courses. Students are scheduled for traditional high school classes along with one or more “Core 42” college classes which are guaranteed to transfer to Missouri colleges/universities. The student will have class period(s) in the school day, designated to work on the MSSU course(s) through an online format.

EARLY COLLEGE ACADEMY

Students attend classes on the campus of St. Charles Community College for up to two years, potentially replacing their junior and senior years of traditional high school. While in the program, students are enrolled in a curriculum consisting of all college coursework taught by professors at SCC alongside other college students. Students beginning this program in their junior year have the potential to earn an Associate of Arts degree as well as a highschool diploma.



WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- Individual Career Academic Plan aligned with College Preparatory Pathway
 - Cumulative GPA requirement
 - Minimum 2.5 for SCC
 - Minimum 3.0 for MSSU
 - History of satisfactory attendance and behavior at Wright City High School
 - Qualifying ACT score may apply
 - Application submitted by due date
- *Must be enrolled at WCHS for one full semester before eligible to apply.*

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF EARLY COLLEGE?

Students planning to pursue postsecondary education have the opportunity to earn college credits while in high school.

This places them on an advanced track towards a college education and reducing their overall cost of higher education.
