



School Bus Safety Rules

- Always listen to your bus driver and follow directions.
- Hold on to handrail going up and down bus steps.
- Seat on Seat, Back on Back, Feet on Floor.
- Face the front of the bus at all times.
- Stay in your assigned seat - no changing seats.
- No standing while bus is in motion.
- Stay seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- Treat others the way you want to be treated.
- No name-calling, profanity, inappropriate language.
- Always keep your hands to yourself.
- Keep the aisles clear - don't put your feet in the aisle.
- No yelling, screaming, or loud talking. Talk quietly with the person sitting next to you.
- No throwing objects.
- No eating or drinking.
- No putting any part of your body out bus window.
- No talking at railroad crossings.
- Never reach for anything under the bus - ask your bus driver for help if you drop something.
- Always watch for your bus driver's hand signal before crossing the street.
