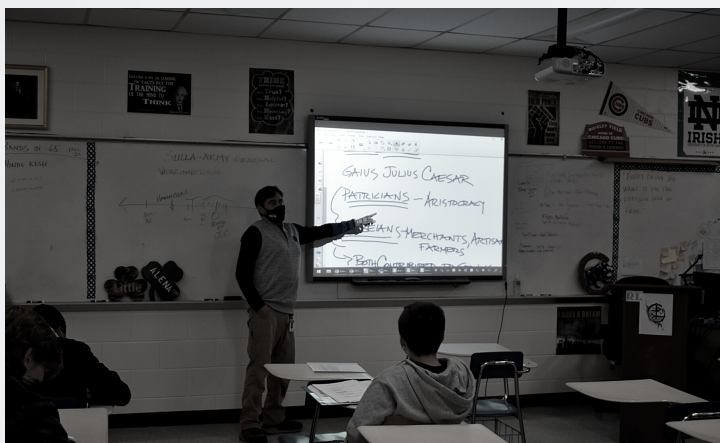

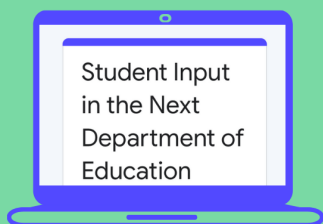


## Pre-Cal SDC Test
