OUR IN-SCHOOL PROCEDURES

Hybrid Schedule for Traditional Students

Due to COVID-19, the school schedule change. As of now, traditional students will follow a hybrid schedule.

Students with Last Names that start with A-L will attend in person Monday-Tuesday,. Wednesday-Friday will be working digitally.

Students with Last Names M-Z will work digitally Monday-Wendnesday. Students will attend in person Thursday & Friday.

MORNINGS

Students riding a bus in the morning will be socially distanced in auditorium. Students will have their temperature checked as they enter the building. At 7:20 AM those students, along with students who walk, ride bikes, or are dropped off will go straight to their 1st period class. Grab and go breakfast will be available.

CLASS EXCHANGE

Students will follow directional tape in the hallways. Stairways on the main hallway will be one direction (except in an emergency). Auditorium side stairs will go UP, and Gym side stairs will go DOWN. Students will not be able to use the bathroom during class changes, they will need to go during class time.

IN CLASSES

Desks will face all one direction. Teachers will work to maximize fresh air to the extent possible while maintaining a working classroom environment. Students will need to keep their essential classroom supplies with them to minimize sharing. High touch surfaces will be cleaned often, and desks and high touch surfaces will be disinfected at least once a dy with a Clorox 360 machine.

LUNCH

We will have 3 lunch times spread out across 3 assigned student locations. All school bought lunches will be grab and go.

END OF THE DAY

The 1st round of bus riders will release at 2:42 PM. Car riders and walkers will be released at 2:45 PM. Car riders will need to report to their grade level section in front of the building. Walkers will need to immediately leave campus. The 2nd round of bus riders will be released at 2:47 PM.
