

This is a very inspirational book and I think everyone should read this! You can find this in the Literacy Library in Mrs.





WHAT TEENS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT IMPEACHMENT?

On September 24, 2019 some leaders in Congress announced an impeachment inquiry against President Donald Trump. Impeachment is carried out by the House of Representatives, and it is accusing government officials of wrongdoing. Impeaching a President takes ¾ vote by the House of Representatives 435 members. Which means that you aren't removed from office by impeachment alone. Crimes that make a President eligible for impeachment are described in the US Constitution as follows, "Treason, Bribery, or other high Crimes and Misdemeanors." If a President has been impeached, or formally charged with a crime, their case is then run by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court and heard by the Senate, who act like a judge and jury, to determine if they are guilty of those crimes or not. A President can only be removed from office with a vote of 3 of the Senate (made up of 100 members). The largest punishment that can result from impeachment is the removal from office and the inability to hold that office in the future.
