Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

Parents will be able to drop students off at HME beginning at 7:30 a.m.

Arrival-Due to construction at the main entrance, students will be entering the school from the second entrance in the front parking lot. This will include all 2nd, 3rd grade, and SPED students along with older siblings K, 1st, 4th, and 5th grade will be dropped off in the gym.
