## Explorer Middle School UNEXCUSED Tardy Consequences

\*NOTE- consequences for tardiness reset each quarter.

<b><u>3 unexcused tardies</u> to ALL classes in ONE week during the same quarter.</b>	<b>Written WARNING and communication with parent(s).</b>
<b><u>4+ unexcused tardies</u> to ALL classes in ONE week during the same quarter.</b>	<b>1 day of lunch detention per tardy and communication with parent(s).</b>
<b><u>10+ unexcused tardies</u> to ALL classes during the same quarter.</b>	<b>1 day of lunch detention for EVERY new tardy in the same quarter and communication with parent(s).</b>  <b>Student may receive one day of in-school or out-of-school suspension for excessive tardiness.</b>

\*Excused tardiness = excused by parent due to doctor appointments, dentist appointment, professional or family business appointment.
