The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. The following agenda items were discussed:

1. PreK-8 Building Committee Update. Mr. Neviaser updated the group on the progress of the building committee noting that the architect and owner's rep interviews are taking place in the next two weeks.
2. Budget. The group revisited their previous discussion related to the movement of capital projects to the undesignated fund. Mr. Griswold, Mr. Sheiness, and Mr. Ward expressed support for reinstating the capital projects to the operating budget.
3. Oil Release Update. Mr. Neviaser reviewed the current status of the oil release response based on the presentation from the LEP at the Board of Education meeting earlier in the week.
4. Budget Referendum. Mr. Lahm and Mr. Griswold requested that the district keep their budget referendum from 12:00-8:00 p.m. on May 2 to ensure enough coverage for poll workers.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.
