LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Hyde Community,

We began the 2019-2020 academic year with the Class of 2020's commitment to leave a legacy of concern and connection. A day at Hyde is filled with our co-curricular program where, simply put, everyone does everything! We all do College Preparatory Academics, Three-Season Competitive Athletics, Performing Arts, Community Service, Discovery Groups, and the Character and Family Programs. 
A Beautiful Way to Honor a Beloved Alumnus ~ Rob Schuller '78

The Rob Schuller Memorial Fund Fit Pit Project

Following the passing of Robert Eliot Schuller on November 30, 2019, members of the Class of 1978 felt compelled to honor Rob's legacy at Hyde, and began discussing how to best honor their friend. Laura Gauld and the Planning Committee Thomas Baez, Scott Bertschy, Jeff Black, and Stu Jones selected a fire pit patio area as their naming opportunity, and initiated the *Rob Schuller Memorial Fund* in January, 2020.

The fire pit project is part of a capital campaign to renovate the performing arts space, and will become the heart of the campus. As of June 30, 2020, gifts and pledges for the memorial fund totaled \$78,000 towards our goal of \$125,000. We are overwhelmed by this outpouring of support from Rob's family, dear friends, and classmates towards creating a special gathering place which students will enjoy for decades to come.

A celebration of Robbie's life will be held on campus on September 18, 2021. Thank you again to the families and friends who have honored his legacy in such a meaningful way.

A New Way to Engage Students

on the Maine Waterways!

We wish to extend our deepest gratitude to Dr. Maureen Yoder and the late Dr. John Yoder, who bestowed a 17-foot Boston Whaler to Hyde shortly after John's passing in October, 2019. They have both been long-time Hyde supporters, counting two children and two grandchildren among the alumni ranks.

John and Maureen were frequent participants in the WFLCs and John was a founding member of the Alumni Parent fly-fishing trips to Grand Lake Stream in Downeast Maine. His love for the outdoors, and fishing in particular, lives on in this incredible gift to the school. The boat gives the school maximum versatility to explore the rivers, lakes and oceans that surround the campus.

During the inaugural trips last summer and fall, over 30 students participated in sightseeing and seal watching trips down the Kennebec River to Fort Popham. Students learned about the local ecology and saw firsthand the beauty of the Maine coast; a highlight was fishing the famed Kennebec River striper run and experiencing the thrill of a singing reel! This special gift will enable students to explore the waterways of Maine for years to come and create lifelong memories.



CASH, CHECKS, AND CREDIT CARD GIFTS

Hyde accepts gifts made as cash, through a valid checking account or by means of a credit or debit card.

MATCHING CORPORATE GIFTS

Hyde welcomes gifts that are matched by donors' employers. The matching gift will be consistent with the purpose of the Hyde donor's gift (usually the Hyde Strong Annual Fund), and they will be credited to the employer's corporate entity with a soft credit to the generating Hyde donor.

GIFTS IN KIND

Gifts of tangible personal property (such as artwork, collections, decorative items, automobiles, boats, etc.) or other gifts in kind may be accepted by Hyde provided that they meet approved needs of the School and do not place an undue burden on the School in terms of their use or maintenance. Hyde strongly suggests that donors consult with their tax advisors whenever considering a gift of this kind. Hyde reserves the right to dispose of any tangible personal property that has been donated, unless otherwise documented.

STOCKS OR SECURITIES

Gifts of appreciated property in the form of publicly traded stock are accepted by Hyde through one of the School's brokerage accounts. Donors are urged to contact the School ahead of the electronic transfer to assure proper application and recording of their gift. Securities transferred by other means, either through the mail or hand delivered, will be treated as transferred on the date that the School takes possession of the securities.
