Caps and Gowns will be distributed on May 16 to those who have satisfied all obligations. Caps and Gowns may not be modified or marked up in any way. Additional cords or stoles besides the ones already provided by Hoban may not be added to a student's cap and gown.

Gentlemen should be clean-shaven and wear dress pants, shirts and ties. No earrings. Ladies should dress in modest dresses. All students must wear dress shoes.

GRADUATION TICKETS

Tickets are reserved via an internet link May 1 -14. Students will receive 2 reserved seat tickets and [8] general admission tickets. Students will receive their graduation tickets when all requirements for graduation are satisfied.

CAP AND GOWN DISTRIBUTION

Provided all graduation requirements have been met, students may pick up their cap and gown on Tuesday, May 16 after Mass. Students in danger of failing a required course will not receive their cap and gown until course requirements have been met. **All tuition and fees must be paid in full through the Business Office by May 8.**
