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What is College Credit Plus?

College Credit Plus allows Ohio students to earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from community colleges or universities.

Our students frequently utilize the following CCP programs from the following universities:

- ★ Columbus State Community College
- ★ Ohio State University Academy Program

Note: Students are able to participate in any other state of Ohio CCP program if they meet the eligibility requirements



How Many Classes Can My Student Take?

- Students are limited to the equivalent of 30 credits per academic year paid for by Olentangy.
- EXAMPLE: A one-credit hour high school academic class is equivalent to 3 college credits, so a student who is scheduled for 7 credit hours already uses 21 credits ($7 \times 3 = 21$). In this scenario, the student would be eligible for 9 CCP credits ($30 - 21 = 9$) at no cost to the student



Where do College Credit Plus classes take place?

- ★ College Credit Plus Classes can be taken either in person on the college campus or online.
- ★ Some online classes have virtual lectures your students will be required to attend (live online).
- ★ Some online classes will have in-person assessments on Main Campus or Delaware Campus (determined by professor)
- ★ In person or live online CCP classes may impact your student's schedule at Liberty High School. Please plan accordingly.
- ★ All CCP classes are scheduled separately from Olentangy Liberty High School courses and need to be discussed with your CCP advisor.



Is College Credit Plus right for my student?

- ★ College Credit Plus courses are **College Level** and require students to work solely with the professor.
- ★ Your student will need to meet certain academic requirements to participate in college credit plus - each college has different requirements.
- ★ A withdrawal (after the deadline) or failure of a CCP course will show up on a high school transcript and affect the student's GPA.
- ★ CCP courses are the start of your student's college transcript.
- ★ Your student should have the maturity, motivation, and effective communication skills to participate in a college course.
- ★ Many students meet the minimum requirement to participate in CCP but may not be prepared for the rigor of these courses.

How does my student begin the CCP process?

College Credit Plus Checklist

1. Complete and return the [Intent to Participate Form](#) to your school counselor by March 31 to be eligible to participate in the CCP program (must be submitted every school year).
2. Apply to the college/university via that school's online CCP application (If you are already a CCP student at that school, you do not need to reapply)
3. Confirm your eligibility (test scores and/or GPA)
4. If accepted, register for your courses (follow the college-specific instructions for registration)
 - NOTE: Colleges run on semesters, so students will have to register for new classes each semester they plan to take courses
5. Read and follow next steps in the registration confirmation email from the institution.

Ohio State Academy CCP Information

- ★ [OSU Academy Application](#) - Due May 1st
- ★ Please inform the school counselor if your student is applying to the OSU CCP Program so they can submit the high school information form and transcript.
- ★ ACT/SAT/AP scores must be submitted via the ACT or College Board websites.
- ★ Course selection and registration will be completed with the CCP advisor.

Important Considerations

Athletic Eligibility/ Full-time Student Status

- One 3-credit CCP course counts for two credits for athletic eligibility
- Full-time student status is 12 credit hours minimum each semester for full-day CCP students; can combine CCP credit hours and high school credits (i.e. three high school classes and one college class EACH semester would be a full-time student)

Transportation

- Transportation is the responsibility of the student/family - OLSD does not provide transportation to college campuses

Potential Cost

- Student is responsible for paying the parking fee for college campus parking (but LHS will waive high school parking fee)
- If a student fails a course or drops it after a certain deadline, the student will be responsible for course payment

Transcript Impact

- CCP course credit/grades are transcribed onto both a college transcript and your high school transcript
- Weighted on a 5.0 scale

Transfer of Credit

- transferology.com
- Guaranteed to transfer to any public university in Ohio
- Some Ohio private colleges will also accept them
- No guarantee of transfer out of state

Registration Dates/Deadlines

- Student is responsible for knowing their respective school's dates/deadlines for applications, course registration, etc.
- Must follow both OLHS and college calendars, which may differ concerning days off, holiday breaks, etc.

NCAA Eligibility

- CCP courses are NCAA approved
