What is TAPA?

The Talon Academy of Performing Arts (TAPA) is an after-school conservatory at Santa Margarita Catholic High School that provides one of the foremost training programs in the country for aspiring performing artists in dance, instrumental music, vocal and theatre arts. Through experiential learning, led by an exceptional faculty who are committed to teaching and developing each student's God-given gifts, TAPA students strive for artistic excellence in a disciplined, nurturing environment. Rooted in the charism of Caritas Christi, TAPA students find purpose and are empowered to employ their artistic talents to make a better world.

Who can enroll?

The program is designed for incoming 9th grade students through 12th grade. Home school and public school students can also enroll.

What if I am a current student?

The conservatory is being expanded and will count toward your Fine Arts credit. But there's more!

 Current TAPA students who enroll in TAPA for 2023-2024 will be given one year credit of the conservatory, and one semester of Fine Arts credit. Fine Arts credit will be granted to TAPA students upon completion of two consecutive years.

How is TAPA different?

Our approach is different. TAPA is process-oriented, with a purpose-driven philosophy of education focused on student growth potential. We carefully designed a scope and sequence of courses with specialties, core courses, and electives in each field. Triple-threat students will receive pre-professional training in acting, music, and dance. The TAPA Steel Drums camp course introduces students to all aspects of steel drum performance. Open to students *with or without prior musical experience.*

Classes: Monday through Thursday (no Fridays)

Session 1: Conservatory Session, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Students in Session 1 will learn playing technique, rote playing, technical studies, basic music theory and basic reading skills on the musical staff.

Session 2: Performance Session, 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

In Session 2 students will learn repertoire in soca, calypso and/or reggae styles, culminating in a live showcase performance for parents, family and friends.
