

ACOMM Making Changes in Education Under the Leadership of Kenneth Peterson

The Association of Multicultural Schools of Mexico (Asociación de Colegios Multiculturales de México or ACOMM), is a select and proactive group of multicultural schools that contribute and propose actions that positively impact the education and formation of the new generations of our country's youth.

ACOMM was founded in 2020, and in 2022, Mr. Kenneth Peterson, Director General of Peterson Schools, has served as President of the Association, in addition to having been a founding member. Throughout this time, more members have joined, and we have currently reached 58 ACOMM member schools from 16 states across the country.

Mr. Peterson has established solid and fruitful relationships with the government for the benefit of the member schools, holding meetings with Dr. Claudia Sheinbaum, Head of Government of Mexico City, and Dr. Renato Berrón Ruiz, Director General of the Institute for Construction Safety of Mexico City (Instituto para la Seguridad de las Construcciones CDMX).

Some of the events organized under the leadership of Mr. Peterson include the First ACOMM Forum, a two-day in-person event for partner members, council presidents and school general directors to attend several conferences and round tables, as well as a dialogue round table about their experiences with the different COVID-19 response protocols and programs.

Additionally, Mr. Peterson has promoted collaboration and the exchange of knowledge and experiences through webinars by experts from different education-related fields. These webinars include:
