This printed newsletter was developed to meet the community's request for more transparency, and more communication about what is happening within the district. However, we understand that a growing number of people are reading this newsletter in electronic form, so we are adapting our process to ensure we're balancing two priorities: being great stewards of funds entrusted to us and providing consistent, transparent communications to residents throughout the district.
