Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Board of Directors of Vancouver College sets the tuition fees annually based on projected revenues and operating costs. At its meeting yesterday evening, the VC Board set the fees for the 2023-2024 school year at \$8,900 per student, an increase of \$300 (3.49%).

As we are experiencing in our daily lives, the cost of living continues to rise. Two areas where this most directly impacts Vancouver College are salaries for teachers and staff, and expenses relating to our important co-curricular programs. Ensuring our school continues to be home to the highly qualified professionals found in our dedicated teachers and staff is of paramount importance in our ability to deliver the high standards VC is known for in its academic, athletic, artistic, and spiritual endeavours. Likewise, educational affordability is central to our mission. As a result, we strive to maintain our tuition at a level that allows VC to be accessible to all families who seek Catholic-based education. With the proposed increase of \$300 in next year's tuition, we seek to satisfy our dual objectives of quality and accessibility during these economically challenging times.

In further support of our Mission, Vancouver College continues with its Financial Assistance Program, fortified thanks to unwavering support from our generous donors, including our alumni through the Vancouver College Alumni Association. We sincerely encourage families who need help meeting tuition, as well as co-curricular fees, to apply for assistance.
