We had a variety of admissions representatives participate in this year's On-Site events. Any student-athlete who is interested in participating in NCAA Division I or Division II athletics must register with the NCAA Eligibility Center: www.eligibilitycenter.org

- * Be Familiar with academic eligibility requirements: Core courses, GPA & Test scores.
- * Make sure that you are taking courses that are NCAA approved!
- * Use the NCAA Eligibility Center Code "9999" when you register to take the SAT or ACT. This allows your scores to be sent directly to the NCAA Eligibility Center.
- * Update your sports participation information regularly!

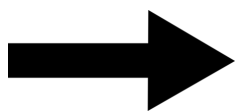


As counselors, we are here to help you create a schedule you will enjoy and will align with your future goals.

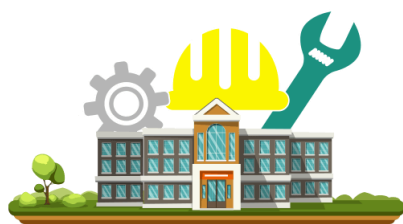

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

Federal Student Aid provides helpful information on the different types of financial aid, aid eligibility, how to apply for aid with the FAFSA, and repaying loans.

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is used to determine student eligibility for federal funds. The FAFSA should be submitted as soon as possible after October 1, 2023.
