

*Don't Squeal, unless it's a Big Deal!* is the book I read to our first graders this week. We focused on understanding the differences between tattling and reporting. Tattling is when it's a kid sized problem and you are telling an adult to get someone else in trouble. Reporting is telling an adult when someone is hurt, stealing or destroying property. To assist with understanding each concept, we used two turkeys, a tattling turkey and a reporting turkey, and matched turkey feathers with situations such as, "Katie fell and has blood on her knee" and "Caitlin won't let me use her tablet" with the correct turkey.
