**MES Counselor's Corner:**

Is your child still struggling with separation anxiety in the mornings before school? Maybe it's been going on since school started or maybe it just started. Whatever the situation is, try to relax and believe it or not, it's completely normal. Some might feel this anxiety and the tears indicate a problem, or that the child feels unhappy at school. But usually the opposite is the case. The tears are usually just for you and once your child is settled into class, they tend to enjoy their day. There are a couple of strategies that can help you and your child through this phase including making sure your child is getting enough sleep each night, doing your best to keep a regular time schedule when dropping off your child at school or to the bus and using key phrases when separating such as, "Goodbye, I'll see you this afternoon." These types of things are tough on the parents and guardians, but hang in there, and if I can be of any assistance, don't hesitate to ask. -Lacy Gross
