RESOLVED, by the Board of School Directors of the Ferndale Area School District, that homestead and farmstead exclusion real estate tax assessment reductions are authorized for the school year beginning July 1, 2018, under the provisions of the Homestead Property Exclusion Program Act (part of Act 50 of 1998) and the Taxpayer Relief Act (Act 1 of 2006), as follows:

1. Aggregate amount available for homestead and farmstead real estate tax reduction. The following amount is available for homestead and farmstead real estate tax reduction:
  - a. Gambling tax funds. The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) has notified the School District that PDE will pay to the School District during the school year pursuant to Act 1, 53 P.S. 6926.505(b), as a property tax reduction allocation funded by gambling tax funds, the amount of \$303,496.
  2. Homestead/farmstead numbers. Pursuant to Act 50, 54 Pa. C.S. 8584(1), and Act 1, 53 P.S. 6926.341(g)(3), the County has provided the School District with a certified report listing approved homesteads and approved farmsteads as follows:
    - a. Homestead property number. The number of approved homesteads within the School District is 1,319.
    - b. Farmstead property number. The number of approved farmsteads within the School District is 2.
    - c. Total homestead/farmstead equals 1,321.

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3. Real estate tax reduction calculation. The homestead exclusion amount and farmstead exclusion amount shall be equal. Dividing the paragraph 1(a) amount available during the school year for real estate tax reduction of \$303,496 by the paragraph 29(c) aggregate number of approved homesteads and approved farmsteads of 1,321, the maximum real estate tax reduction amount applicable to each approved homestead/farmstead.
  
4. Homestead exclusion calculation. Dividing the paragraph 3 maximum real estate tax reduction amount of \$229.75 by the School District real estate tax rate of 84 mills (.084), the maximum real estate assessed value reduction to be reflected on tax notices as a homestead exclusion for each approved homestead is \$2,735.09, and the maximum real estate assessed value reduction to be reflected on tax notices as a farmstead exclusion for each approved farmstead is \$2,735.09.
  
5. Homestead/farmstead exclusion authorization July 1 tax bills. The tax notice issued to the owner of each approved homestead within the School District shall reflect a homestead exclusion real estate assessed value reduction equal to the lesser of: (a) the County established assessed value of the homestead, or (b) the paragraph 4 maximum real estate assessed value reduction of \$2,735.09. The tax notice issued to the owner of each approved farmstead within the School District shall reflect an additional farmstead exclusion real estate assessed value reduction equal to the lesser of: (a) the County established assessed value of the farmstead, or (b) the paragraph 4 maximum real estate assessed value reduction of \$2,735.09. For purposes of this Resolution, "Approved homestead" and "approved farmstead" shall mean homesteads and farmsteads listed in the report referred to in paragraph 2 above and received by the School District from the County Assessment Office on or before May 1 pursuant to Act 1, 53 P.S. 6926.341(g)(3), based on homestead/ farmstead applications filed with the County Assessment Office on or before March 1. This paragraph 5 will apply to tax notices issued based on the initial tax duplicate used in issuing initial real estate tax notices for the school year, which will be issued on or promptly after July 1, and will not apply to interim real estate tax bills.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to the authority granted to  
23 school districts in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by Act of  
24 Assembly approved March 10, 1948, P.L. 30, Article VI, Section 679, as  
25 amended, a per capita tax in the amount of \$5.00 is imposed upon all  
26 persons residing in said district over the age of eighteen (18) during the  
27 School Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2016, and the Resolution of June 26,  
28 1974, as amended by taxing resolution of June 30, 1981, imposing a like  
29 tax is hereby re-enacted for the School Fiscal Year 2017-18. 29

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31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all taxpayers who made payment of  
32 the aforesaid \$5.00 per capita tax enacted pursuant to the authority of the  
33 Act of March 10, 1948, P.L. 30, Article VI, Section 679 as amended, and  
34 the aforesaid real estate taxes within two (2) months after the date of the  
35 tax notice shall receive a discount of 2% of the face amount thereof. All  
36 taxpayers who fail to made payment of such taxes shall, in addition to  
37 interest otherwise provided by law, be subject to, and required to pay, a  
38 penalty in the amount of 10% of the face amount of the tax due, which  
39 penalty shall be added to the taxes due and be collected by the Tax  
40 Collector, and further, shall be in addition to interest and other charges due  
41 thereon which are assessed pursuant to applicable law. 41
