Minutes	January minutes were unanimously approved (4-0).
Summer School	 Board hasn't responded to the summer school addendum to Trust Lands Plan. Assessment department has assured us it will be approved. Before/After School is also trying to host a summer school program this year.
Trust Lands Plan and Timeline	 Mid-year testing results were shared with the council. The reading goal was 45% of students making typical or better growth testing showed that 58% of students hit that mark. The council discussed whether growth or proficiency measures should be used on the Trust Land Plan next year. The council weighed the advantages of each method and eventually agreed that measuring growth would be better for the school. The council agreed on a goal of 60% of students making typical or better growth next year. Writing results were also discussed. The goal for this year was 45% of students "proficient" at the mid-year. 62% of students were at or above state and district averages at mid-year. The council agreed that next years goal would be to increase the school's scores by one point on the ten point rubric. Both academic goals will be presented to faculty members for discussion.
Other Items	 Council members were invited to participate in the Title I compact night on April 13th. The new legislation about full-day kindergarten was briefly discussed along with its impact on Crestview.
