Minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • January minutes were unanimously approved (4-0).
Summer School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Board hasn't responded to the summer school addendum to Trust Lands Plan. • Assessment department has assured us it will be approved. • Before/After School is also trying to host a summer school program this year.
Trust Lands Plan and Timeline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mid-year testing results were shared with the council. • The reading goal was 45% of students making typical or better growth... testing showed that 58% of students hit that mark. • The council discussed whether growth or proficiency measures should be used on the Trust Land Plan next year. • The council weighed the advantages of each method and eventually agreed that measuring growth would be better for the school. • The council agreed on a goal of 60% of students making typical or better growth next year. • Writing results were also discussed. The goal for this year was 45% of students "proficient" at the mid-year. • 62% of students were at or above state and district averages at mid-year. • The council agreed that next years goal would be to increase the school's scores by one point on the ten point rubric. • Both academic goals will be presented to faculty members for discussion.
