1. Four-H member must turn in a 4-H Portfolio and at least one project book (grades 9-12 turn in portfolios only) to participate in 4-H Fest. All contests are open to all eligible 4-H'ers.

2. Four-H member must bring pencil, paper, and equipment supplies needed for all contests.

- 3. Each club should prepare a song or yell to do as a group at 4-H Fest. To save time, we are limiting this contest to either a song or yell. Songs and yells will be judged together. Also, songs and yells must be performed from the seating area. Song or yell should not be any longer than 3 minutes and must include your school/club's name.
- 4. List of contestants must be turned in by 4pm, March 27, 2023, to the 4-H office. Only registered contestants will be eligible to participate. All contests are open to any eligible 4-H'er. You should register only for the contests noted as needing registration. Some of the contests do not require prior registration of the contestants. If you would like to make changes after your registration sheet has been turned in, please do so by calling our office the week prior to 4-H Fest.
- 5. Exhibits must be labeled and turned in upon arrival at 4-H Fest. They should be picked up before leaving the arena. Below are some sample tags that you may use on bird/insect/leaf exhibits. All labels should include Name, Club/School, and Grade for judging.

Contests Open to Fourth Graders

- 1) <u>Discovering 4-H Demonstration</u>: A team of two will give a demonstration on any topic from the Discovering 4-H book. (3 teams per club) Registration is not required.
- 2) <u>Bird Exhibits</u>: Bring a birdhouse <u>**OR**</u> birdfeeder that you have made. <u>**Registration is required.**</u> (10 per club)
- 3) <u>Insect Collections:</u> Bring an insect collection with 15 mounted and identified insects. (10 per club) <u>Registration is required.</u>
- 4) <u>Leaf Collections</u>: Bring a leaf collection of 15 leaves that are mounted in a notebook and identified. (10 per club) <u>Registration is required.</u>
- 5) <u>Insect Identification</u>: Identify 15 insects by common name. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 6) <u>Leaf Identification</u>: Identify 15 native trees by common name. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 7) <u>Horticulture Crops</u>: 4-H'er will judge specimens or vegetables, fruits and/or ornamentals. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 8) <u>Plant Science:</u> Identify ten weeds and ten seeds by common name. (4 per club) Registration is not required.
- 9) <u>Dairy Judging:</u> Judge a class of dairy cows or heifers and give a written set of reasons explaining placings. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 10) <u>Dairy Poster:</u> Bring a poster (22" X 28") that promotes the consumption of milk and/or milk products. Do NOT attach anything more than ½" thick to poster. Overall winning posters will not be returned. Registration is not required.
- 11) <u>Public Speaking:</u> 4-Her will write and give a speech on any subject limited to 3 to 5 minutes. (Only 3 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 12)<u>Club Reporter (Scrapbook) Contest:</u> Submit a scrapbook of the current school years 4-H club activities. Include pictures, news articles, etc., and the reporter record sheet. Club scrapbooks will be due at the same time as 4-H Portfolios (record books). **Registration is required.**
- 13) Shooting Sports: There are 2 tests in this category: 1. Skins & Skulls Identification 2.

 Archery. No equipment is necessary/or permitted. All equipment will be provided by 4-H. (ONLY 4 members from each club can participate)

 Registration is required. If more than 4 per club show up, they will be turned away.
- 14) Fishing Sports: There are 2 tests in this category: 1. Fishing ID test 2. Casting Competition. No equipment is necessary/or permitted. All equipment will be provided by 4-H. (ONLY 4 members from each club can participate) Registration is required. If more than 4 per club show up, they will be turned away.

If more names are submitted than allowed in each contest.

Only the correct number for each contest will be allowed to participate.

All contests are open to any eligible 4-H'er.

Contests Open to Fifth and Sixth Graders

- 1. **Agriculture Team Demonstration: A team of two 5th and/or 6th graders will demonstrate a worthwhile agricultural or related practice. (3 teams per club) **Registration is not required.
- 2. **Home Economics Team Demonstration: A team of two 5th and/or 6th graders will demonstrate a worthwhile home economics or related practice. Cooking will not be allowed. teams per club) **Registration is not required.
- 3. <u>Bird Exhibits:</u> Bring a birdhouse <u>**OR**</u> birdfeeder made by you. <u>**Registration is required.**</u> (10 per club).
- 4. <u>Insect Collections</u>: Bring an insect collection of at least 20 mounted and identified insects you have collected. <u>Registration is required</u>. (10 per club).
- 5.<u>Leaf Collections</u>: Bring a leaf collection of 15 leaves that are mounted in a notebook and identified. **Registration is required.** (10 per club).
- 6 Insect Identification: Identify 15 insects by common name. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 7 <u>Leaf Identification</u>: Identify 15 native trees by common name. (4 members per club) Registration not required.
- 8 <u>Horticulture Crops:</u> 4-H'er will judge specimens or vegetables, fruits and/or ornamentals. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 9 <u>Plant Science</u>: Identify ten weeds and ten seeds by common name. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 10 <u>Meat Identification</u>: Identify 20 cuts of meat by species and retail cut. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 11 <u>Dairy Judging</u>: Judge a class of dairy cows or heifers and give a written set of reasons explaining placings. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 12 <u>Dairy Poster:</u> Bring a poster (22" X 28") that promotes the consumption of milk and/or milk products. Do NOT attach anything more than ½" thick to poster. Overall winning posters will not be returned. Registration is not required.
- 13 <u>Public Speaking:</u> 4-Her will write and give a speech on any subject limited to 3 to 5 minutes. (3 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 14 <u>Club Reporter (Scrapbook) Contest:</u> Submit a scrapbook of the current school years 4-H club activities. Include pictures, news articles, etc., and the reporter record sheet. Club scrapbooks will be due at the same time as 4-H Portfolios (record books). <u>Registration is required.</u>
- 15 <u>Shooting Sports:</u> There are 2 tests in this category: 1. Skins & Skulls Identification 2. Archery No equipment is necessary/or permitted. All equipment will be provided by 4-H.

(ONLY 4 members from each club can participate) Registration is required.

- <u>16 Fishing Sports:</u> There are 2 tests in this category: 1. Fishing ID test 2. Casting Competition. No equipment is necessary/or permitted. All equipment will be provided by 4-H. (ONLY 4 members from each club can participate) Registration is required.
- 17 <u>Photography (6th graders):</u> Submit scrapbook or pictures as instructed in Photography project book with 4-H Portfolio (record book). Registration is not required.

Contests Open to Seventh through Twelfth Graders

- 1) **General Demonstration Team: Agriculture: Two 4-H members will present a 10-minute demonstration on topic related to Agriculture Practice. (Only 3 teams per club) **Registration is not required.
- 2) **General Demonstration Team Home Economics: Two 4-H members will present a 10-minute demonstration on a topic relating to Home Economics. No Cooking!

 (Only 3 teams per club) **Registration is not required.
- 3) <u>Bird Exhibits</u>: Bring your birdhouse <u>**OR**</u> bird feeder that you made. <u>**Registration is required**</u> (10 per club)
- 4) <u>Insect Collection:</u> Bring an insect collection with at least 15 mounted and identified insects. (10 per club) **Registration is required.**
- 5) <u>Leaf Identification:</u> Identify 25 native trees to Louisiana from their leaves. (4 per club) Registration is not required.
- 6) <u>Insect Identification:</u> Identify 15 insects to common name and order. (4 per club) Registration is not required.
- Horticulture Judging: 4-H'er will judge specimens of vegetables, fruits, and/or ornamentals.
- 7) (4 per club) Registration is not required.
- 8) Plant Science: You will take a test identifying seeds and weeds. (4 per club) Registration is not required.
- Meat Identification: Identify 20 cuts of meat by species and retail cut. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- Dairy Judging: Judge a class of dairy cows or heifers and give a written set of reasons explaining placings. (4 members per club) Registration is not required.
- Dairy Poster: Bring a poster (22" X 28") that promotes the consumption of milk and/or milk products. Do NOT attach anything more than ½" thick to poster. Registration is not required. Overall winning posters will not be returned.
- 12) Public Speaking: 4-H'er will write and give a speech on any subject limited to 3 to 5 minutes. (3 members per club) Registration is not required.
- 13) Club Reporter (Scrapbook) Contest: Submit a scrapbook of the current school years 4-H club activities. Include pictures, news articles, etc. and the reporter record sheet.

 Club scrapbooks will be due at the same time as 4-H Portfolios (record books).

 Registration is required.
- 14. <u>Photography:</u> Submit scrapbook or pictures as instructed in Photography project book with 4-H Portfolio (record book). Registration is not required.

15. <u>Fishing Sports:</u> There are 2 tests in this category: 1. Fishing ID test 2. Casting Competition. No equipment is necessary/or permitted. All equipment will be provided by 4-H. (4 members from each club can participate) Registration is required.

16. <u>Shooting Sports:</u> There are 2 tests in this category: 1. Skins & Skulls Identification 2. Archery. No equipment is necessary/or permitted. All equipment will be provided by 4H. **(4 members from each club can participate.) Registration is required.**

If more names are submitted than allowed in each contest, only the correct number for each contest will be allowed to participate, all others will be turned away.

**If a 4-H member competes in the Agricultural Team Demonstration he/she may not compete in the Home Economics Team Demonstration and vise-versa. **

ALL CONTESTS ARE OPEN TO ANY ELIGIBLE 4-H'ER. YOU NO LONGER NEED TO COMPLETE A PROJECT BOOK PERTAINING TO CONTEST SUBJECT IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THAT CONTEST.

PARISH 4-H FEST AWARDS

- A. **MOST OUTSTANDING CLUB** The total number of points that each club accumulates in all qualifying contests will be tabulated. The club in each division accumulating the highest number of points will receive a Most Outstanding Club trophy. A second and third place trophy will also be given.
- B. MOST OUTSTANDING INDIVIDUALS IN PARISH The top five 4-H members among all parish 4-H members in each age division accumulating the highest number of points in all qualifying contests will receive medals. All 4-H members are eligible for this award.
- C. **MOST VALUABLE CLUB MEMBERS** It will be the discretion of the club leader to determine the top two club members for the club. Areas for judging include: 4-H project work, contest participation, community service, leadership activities, and enthusiasm for the 4-H program. The top two most valuable club members will receive medals. All 4-H members are eligible for this award.
- D. **CLUB BANNER AWARD** The club in each division accumulating the highest score will receive a Banner trophy. A second and third place trophy will also be given.
- E. **CLUB SONG AND YELL AWARD** The club in each division accumulating the highest score will receive a Song & Yell trophy. A second and third place trophy will also be given.

NOTE: Clubs who have mixed age divisions will compete in the age division that includes the largest number of 4-Hers enrolled. Clubs who have mixed age divisions must be in the same school or must have the approval of the 4-H office when organized.
