Your child will be immersed in a stimulating learning environment filled with fun, challenging, and creative learning activities! Join us to get a jump-start on kindergarten readiness.

There are many preschool options available to families in Eden Prairie, but Little Eagles Preschool program is the only one that aligns with Eden Prairie Schools K-12 curriculum and the overall K-12 system. We work closely with Early Childhood Special Education and kindergarten teachers to foster a successful transition from preschool to kindergarten.

Curriculum Focused on Personalized Learning

At Eden Prairie Schools, our mission is to inspire each student every day. Our preschool is designed to create excitement around education and provide a foundation for lifelong learning. We use Creative Curriculum, which is a balanced approach of all social-emotional and academic areas. We focus on personalized learning for your child. Lessons are designed around your child's skills to prepare them for kindergarten and beyond. Throughout the school year, staff conduct assessments using the whole child approach utilizing the Teaching Strategies GOLD observation based assessment tool.

^{**} If you're looking for care outside of the preschool hours for your child, enroll in our RE program. After students complete their morning preschool session (9:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.) they will go to lunch and engage in Rest and Enrichment (RE) from 12:00-3:45 p.m.

The Rest and Enrichment (RE) portion of the day is child care provided through Community Education. Preschoolers will continue to have their highly qualified teacher and paraprofessionals in the classroom, but will be expected to follow the program and classroom routine which includes rest, lunch, and enrichment activities.

If your child has an IEP, special education services are provided during the morning preschool session (9:30 a.m.–12:00 p.m.) and the afternoon session (1:15–3:45 p.m.). If your student is enrolled in AM + Rest and Enrichment (RE), special education services are provided during the morning preschool time (9:30 a.m.–12:00 p.m.). During the RE portion of the day (12:00–3:45 p.m.), accommodations and modifications for support will be implemented through collaboration of the special education and general education team.

3 YEAR OLD PRESCHOOL INFORMATION

LOCATION

All 3 year old preschool programming is held at Lower Campus, 8100 School Road, Eden Prairie, MN 55344. Use door #11.

TRANSPORTATION FOR 3 YEAR OLDS

Only 3 year olds who meet certain eligibility requirements will qualify for transportation.

WHAT IS PRESCHOOL AM AND RE?

Little Eagles does not offer a "Full Day Program" but offers a 6 hour program to meet child care needs of families. After students complete their morning preschool session (9:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.) they will go to lunch and engage in Rest and Enrichment (RE) from 12:00-3:45 p.m.

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Special Education services are provided during the morning preschool session (9:30 a.m.–12:00 p.m.). Accommodations and modifications will be implemented through collaboration of the special education and general education team, but services and support are not provided in the RE portion of the day (12:00–3:45 p.m.).

DO YOU HAVE CARE ON DAYS THERE IS NO SCHOOL?

Preschool does not have child care on days the district does not have school.

DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BE TOILET INDEPENDENT?

Children should be toilet independent or must be actively toilet training before entering preschool, meaning they have:

- the ability to identify and verbalize the urge to use the restroom in a timely manner
- the ability to manage all self-help/toileting skills independently
- the ability to manage their preschool day including rest time without a pull-up

We are aware that it is developmentally appropriate for children of this age to have accidents from time to time. In the event that your child needs additional support through toilet training, classroom staff and Parent Educators will work with you and your child.

WHAT IF MY CHILD TURNS 3 AFTER SEPTEMBER 1, 2023?

PRESCHOOL SAMPLER

This class is designed for children to ease into the world of preschool. Children will 'practice' preschool during this drop-off class, available as a one or two day session. Students will strengthen their independence and will be ready to soar as a Little Eagle into preschool. Children must be 3 by the start of class, and actively toilet training to enroll in Preschool Sampler. This class is held at Lower Campus.

Available as a 3 or 4 day consistent schedule, students have the opportunity to enjoy a typical preschool classroom without a full week commitment. Preschoolers will experience social-emotional development through play-based learning, and be introduced to elementary school experiences such as eating lunch in the cafeteria, riding the bus to and from school*, and building relationships with elementary staff. It is a great way to help your child on the road to kindergarten readiness!

As the year progresses, if it is the right fit for your student and your family, there is an opportunity to modify your enrollment to a full week schedule.


WHERE: Little Eagles 4 year old preschool is held at the 5 Elementary Schools:

4 YEAR OLD PRESCHOOL

MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD BY SEPT. 1, 2023.

Create a school community connection, reduce transitions and prepare your child for Kindergarten through Little Eagles 4 year old preschool at one of our five Elementary Schools. Through interactive, stimulating and academically rich programming, your child will practice academic, social and emotional skills to prepare for Kindergarten. 4 year old preschoolers will also have lunch as a part of their preschool day. You have the option of bringing a lunch from home or purchasing a school lunch for an additional fee. We have dedicated preschool transportation to and from school for children living within the Eden Prairie School district boundary.

4 YEAR OLD PRESCHOOL INFORMATION

LOCATIONS/BOUNDARY SCHOOLS

4 year old preschool programming has moved to Eden Prairie Schools' five Elementary Schools*.

Can I attend a school other than my boundary school? We encourage families to attend their boundary school. Busing is not provided if a family attends a school outside of their boundary school. Students will not automatically be enrolled for this school for K-12, they must follow the district transfer protocol.

Our older child attends Eagle Heights Spanish Immersion, now what? Proof of a sibling attending Eagle Heights is required to enroll in Oak Point if it is not the boundary school for the family.

Can I open enroll from another district? Residents of surrounding communities are welcome to enroll their child at Little Eagles Preschool. Contracts will be accepted based on availability of space and transportation is not available.

Our Family School Program is intended to support entire families in their learning. This program offers free English classes for adults, preschool for 3 and 4 years old, as well as an infant/toddler classroom for younger children. The Adult English classes are provided by Metro South Adult Basic Education and take place 9:45 a.m. –12:00 p.m. Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays, depending on class level. Prior to starting participants will have to take an online comprehension reading exam.

Nuestro Programa de Escuela Familiar está destinado a apoyar a familias enteras en su aprendizaje. Este programa ofrece clases de inglés gratuitas para adultos, preescolar para niños de 3 y 4 años, así como un salón de clases para bebés y niños pequeños para niños más pequeños. RESOURCES FOR FAMILIES

EARLY CHILDHOOD SPECIAL EDUCATION

Eden Prairie Schools Community Education works with children of all abilities. Our staff work with enrolled families to provide reasonable accommodations as needed for each child. The goal for all children is to have independent, meaningful participation in the program.

All children participating in programming must consistently demonstrate the ability to follow adult direction, show readiness for large group activities, including the ability to remain with the group, and follow safety rules.

Children need to meet state eligibility criteria in order to receive Early Childhood Special Education services. Questions and concerns regarding your child's development are welcomed. For additional information, contact the Early Childhood Special Education Office at 952-975-6979.

Have you scheduled your child's Early Childhood Screening?

Make an Appointment TODAY!

Join us at Early Childhood Screening as soon as your child turns 3!

This is a **FREE** and simple check of how your child is growing and developing. It is a requirement of the State of Minnesota for all preschool-aged children.

WHAT AGE SHOULD MY CHILD BE SCREENED?

Screening is preferred at age 3, but can be done at 4 or 5. The earlier, the better! Waiting until a child is in school may be too long. If your child will be starting kindergarten in the fall, or if you have a concern about your child's development, please make an appointment for Early Childhood Screening.

WHERE IS SCREENING HELD?

Screening appointments are held in the Administrative Building at 8100 School Road, Eden Prairie. Enter at the Welcome Center entrance, door #1, and they will direct you where to go.

HOW DO I SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT?

The state of Minnesota requires that all children be screened before they enter kindergarten. Schedule your appointment today:

WHAT DATES ARE SCREENING APPOINTMENTS CURRENTLY AVAILABLE?

Screening appointments are available on various dates and times including evenings. Check our website or call to find out about a date and time that will work for your schedule.

WHAT INFORMATION IS GATHERED AT SCREENING?

Screening questions are tailored specifically to your child's age.
Discover more about your child's development and learning, such as:

- Thinking, language, and communication skills
- Social and emotional development
- Large and small muscle coordination
- Height, weight, hearing, and vision

Early Childhood Screening is one way to support children in their early years of growth and development. It is also a way to identify children who may benefit from early childhood special services before they enter school and connects families with the appropriate resources and programs.

WHAT DOES SCREENING COST?

Early Childhood Screening is FREE! During screening, each child also receives a free book funded from Eden Prairie Community Foundation.



READY! for Kindergarten is part of our ECFE program for which classes are priced on a sliding fee scale based on your household income. Payment is made in full at time of registration.

Ready! for Kindergarten is a nationally recognized program shown to give parents and caregivers the skills and tools to help their children enter kindergarten at or above grade level. Designed for families with children ages 3 to 5.5 years. This class will include training on the reading, writing, and social-emotional skills that children need to thrive in school. The in-person training is for parents and guardians to learn how to utilize the learning tools with their children. Childcare is available for your child while you attend the class.

At the training you will receive a collection of high-quality toys (learning tools) to further your child's progress towards school readiness. Please note: There is a Fall, Winter and Spring session with new content and new learning tools, so register for all three sessions!

Ready! for Kindergarten is funded through a grant from The Foundation for Eden Prairie Schools (FEPS) and only available at no cost to Eden Prairie residents that meet the income requirement.

PRESCHOOL CLASS FEE

There is a \$75 non-refundable registration fee for school-year preschool classes. Payment for September is charged on August 15th; the remaining eight payments are charged on the 1st of the month from October through May.

BIRTH DATE GUIDELINES

For both ECFE and preschool classes, please select your class based on your child's age by Sept. 1, 2023. This age requirement aligns with district kindergarten age requirements.

BIRTH CERTIFICATE

A copy of your child's birth certificate is required for any child participating in ECFE or preschool. They can be emailed to EPS_ LittleEagles@edenpr.org or dropped off at the Early Childhood office.

IMMUNIZATION LAW

All students in Minnesota must have immunizations up-to-date and on record with the school before the child starts class. Immunization forms are available online at www.edenpr.org/earlychildhood.

PHOTOS AND VIDEO POLICY

Class participants in our programs may be photographed and filmed for marketing purposes (e.g., website, social media, catalog and flyers). If you would prefer not to have you or your child photographed or filmed please email comed@edenpr.org after registering.

CANCELLATION POLICY FOR PRESCHOOL

Any changes to the child's schedule, including withdrawal from the program, must be given 10 business days prior to when the change is needed. If notice is not given, two weeks of tuition will be charged to the account. A \$20 processing fee is charged for all cancellations and classroom changes. No refunds are given for emergency or weather closings or for days missed due to illness or vacation. Please note, the (\$75) registration fee is non-refundable.

FEE ASSISTANCE FOR PRESCHOOL

Limited tuition assistance is provided for qualifying families toward half-day preschool only.
