

Hellgate Elementary Board of Trustees
 Special Meeting April 27, 2022

OPENING

The Board of Trustees of Hellgate Elementary School District #4 met in special session on Wednesday, April 27, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. The meeting was held in-person and also broadcast by virtual video conferencing. The meeting was called to order by Board Chairman, Tom McLaughlin. Trustees present were: Tom McLaughlin, Rod Sharkey, Jack Babon, and Diane Beck. Trustees Lori Christensen and Rich Thornock joined the meeting via Zoom video conference. Trustee Kate Walker were absent. There were up to 12 in-person and online participants in the meeting.

CONSIDER ADMINISTRATIVE POSITION RECOMMENDATION

A motion was made by Jack Babon to approve the superintendent's recommendation to offer the Hellgate Elementary Director of Special Services position to Mr. Brendan Brown for the 2022-2023 school year. The motion was seconded by Rod Sharkey. There was discussion on the item. Voting in favor of the motion were Tom McLaughlin, Rod Sharkey, Jack Babon, Diane Beck, Lori Christensen and Rich Thornock. Voting against the motion were none. The motion passed.

CONSIDER TEACHING POSITION RECOMMENDATIONS

A motion was made by Rod Sharkey to approve the superintendent's recommendation to offer a one-year only certified teaching position to Ms. Hannah Hughes, as a Hellgate Elementary Special Education teacher, for the 2022-2023 school year. The motion was seconded by Jack Babon. Voting in favor of the motion were Tom McLaughlin, Rod Sharkey, Jack Babon, Diane Beck, Lori Christensen and Rich Thornock. Voting against the motion were none. The motion passed.

A motion was made by Rod Sharkey to approve the superintendent's recommendation to offer Ms. Ashley Hofland a teaching position (4th grade or 6th grade) for the 2022-2023 school year. The motion was seconded by Rich Thornock. Voting in favor of the motion were Tom McLaughlin, Rod Sharkey, Jack Babon, Diane Beck, Lori Christensen and Rich Thornock. Voting against the motion were none. The motion passed.

DISTRICT CLERK/BUSINESS MANAGER INTERVIEW

Ms. Justine Reese was on-site to interview for the Hellgate Elementary District Clerk/Business Manager position. The interview began at approximately 10:11 am and concluded at approximately 10:45 am.
