## TITLE 20. EDUCATION

### CHAPTER 7. SCHOOL INSTRUCTION AND SPECIAL PROGRAMS

#### Part 1. Accreditation and Curriculum

#### **“Transparency And Public Availability Of Public School Performance Data -- Reporting -- Availability For Timely Use To Improve Instruction “**

Section 20-7-104, MCA, requires schools to report to the Montana OPI and, subsequently, publish on the Hellgate Elementary website certain information that the school district is required to collect and publish. In compliance with 20-7-104, Hellgate Elementary provides the following information and the links (where applicable) to access that information:

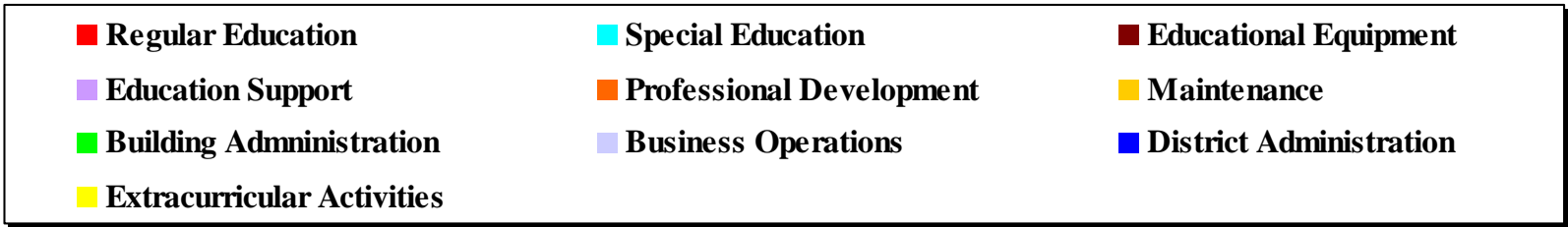
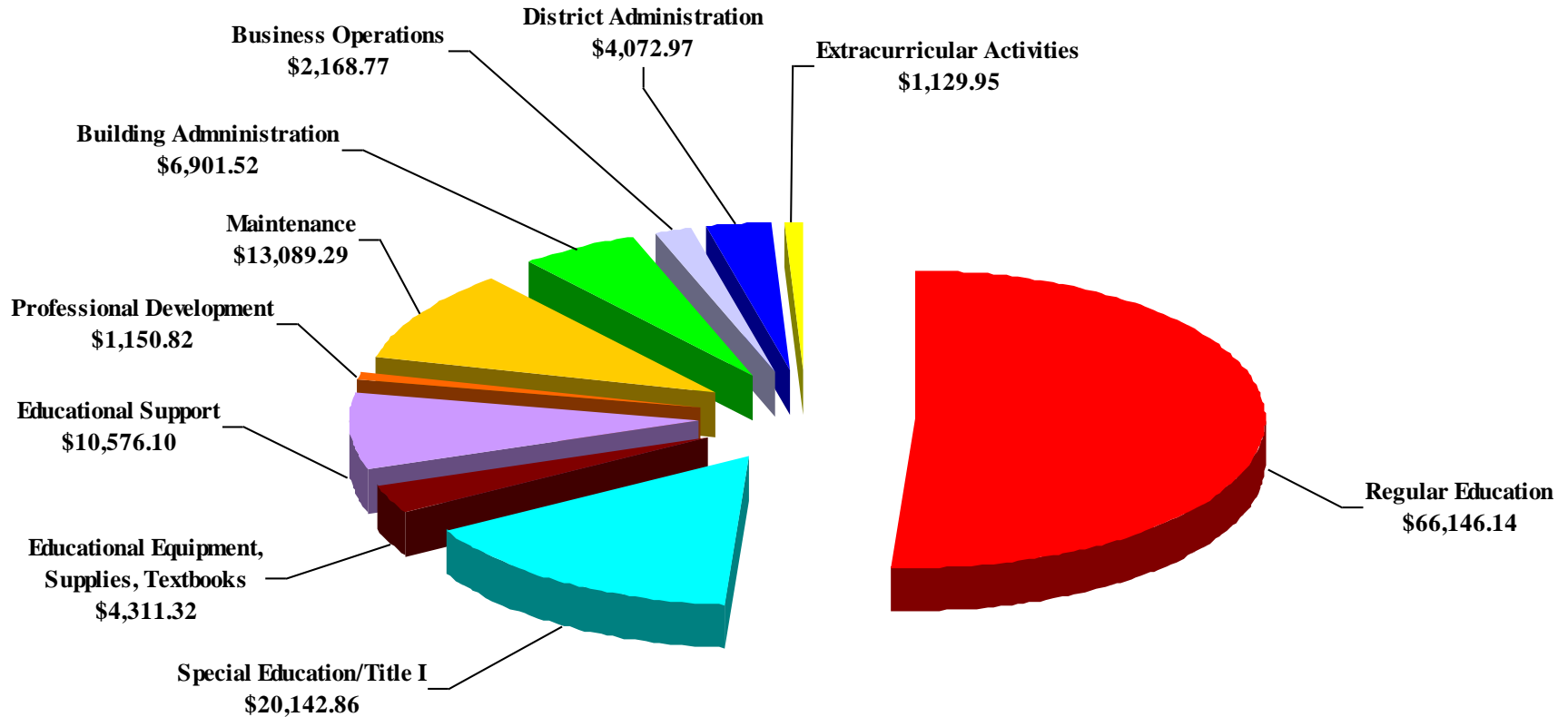
