IV. Superintendent Report

A. Updates

Dr. Maria Rianna noted that the district is considering guidance from the CDC, the American Association of Pediatrics and items specific to Glen Cove. Mentioned that a mask mandate will be enforced for students and staff while indoors and further discussions as to whether lunches will be provided in the classrooms at the elementary level due to space restrictions. A meeting on this is scheduled for next week. Teacher assistants are assigned in every elementary classroom in the event there's an emergency closure or quarantines, the teacher assistants can help with the transition.

Middle and high schools will have additional spaces utilized for lunch.

No remote option is being offered at this time. Student's that require medical accommodations will be reviewed and a 504 plan will be put in place for those students if needed.

Still awaiting information regarding high risk sports however, until then we will be having a regular season. In-person clubs and extra-curricular activities will be running this year, and lockers are available for student use.

In the event of a shut down or any weather emergencies permitted from the state education department, virtual days may be utilized as needed.

Will continue to minimize and monitor visitors and will continue with the regular screening protocol of temperature checking as it has worked.

Every elementary building will have a social worker added to its support staff for the well-being and social emotional support for all students.

We're waiting on conversations with the new state Governor as she will provide guidance and mandates regarding school openings and we'll make adjustments as necessary.

A Board work session will be scheduled to discuss stimulus monies and previous bond projects and current needs and prioritizing projects determining what the district will move forward with. Back to school packets will be forwarded to families next week. Also thanked staff that has already reached out to students.


