School Board Election Results of May 15, 2018

The Meeting was called to order at 9:43 pm by the District Clerk who announced the election results as follows:

Roll Call: Call to Order

The Board of Education, meeting as a Board of Canvass, examined and tabulated the statement of the results of the Annual School District election in several election districts, held on May 15, 2018. The Board proceeded to canvass the returns as contained in such statements and determine the number of votes cast for the Board candidates and finds the votes cast in the several election districts to be as follows:

Noted: Gail Nedbor-Gross elected with 851 votes;
Rosemarie Sekelsky elected with 766 votes and Mary Murphy elected with 645 votes all for a three year term

On motion by Trustee Huggins, seconded by Trustee Nedbor-Gross the Board (7/0) unanimously at 9:43 pm noted that Gail Nedbor-Gross received the highest number of votes and was elected to a three (3) year term beginning July 1, 2018 and that Rosemarie Sekelsky received the second highest number of votes and is elected to a three (3) year term beginning July 1, 2018 and that Mary Murphy received the third highest number of votes and is elected to a three (3) year term beginning July 1, 2018.

Noted: Budget Passed with 857 Yes Votes; 475 No Votes


