Dear Bellevue Union School District Families and Staff,

As the end of December approaches, we are thrilled with the progress our educators, staff, and students have made this year. We are thriving and we continue to hone our instructional practices and strategies to best meet the unique needs of our students. We have concluded the first series of grade level collaboration days with a focus on our English Language Arts program. Staff worked collaboratively to align our instruction and build coherence at all sites throughout the district. Great conversations, dialogue, and debate ensued, and we are bolstering the District's capacity to increase student academic achievement. We will continue meeting with the grade levels when we return from the winter break to carry on our discussions and build upon our common assessments and measurable outcomes.

Please be on the lookout for the Youth Truth Survey in the new year. Our families will be asked to participate in completing this survey to help provide the District with input and feedback that will drive our Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) and School Plans for Student Achievement (SPSA). It is essential that we hear from all of our educational partners as we begin planning for the next school year.

We would also like to have folks put a hold on their calendars for the next District English Language Advisory Committee (DELAC) meeting on January 31, 2023, at 9:00, in the Learning Center on the Meadow View campus. We will be discussing our English Language Master Plan and we need your voice and ideas.
