## Curriculum and English Learners: Aracely Romo-Flores, Director (curriculum@busd.org)

The District has been reviewing the instructional methods and strategies we are implementing in order to strengthen the academic programs in our schools. We are meeting in district grade level teams to discuss the quality of learning time, how to continue to provide an enriched and accelerated curriculum, and how to address the needs of all children at the school sites. Grade level teams are collaborating to ensure coherence throughout the district to guarantee that all students are receiving a similar educational experience. Great efforts have been made to learn a variety of new curriculums that help support teachers in differentiating their approaches to student learning. Teachers are learning and utilizing the tools to help them provide additional interventions and opportunities for acceleration for their diverse student classrooms.

BUSD has offered a variety of professional development training for staff and it is exciting to see the new learning being implemented in the classrooms and on the playgrounds. These trainings include, but are

not limited to: Guided Language Acquisition Design (GLAD), Writing by Design, Systematic Instruction in Phonological Awareness, Phonics, and Sight Words (SIPPS), and Comprehension Strategies. As we continue to review student data and strive to support all students with acquiring the necessary skills to be successful scholars, we are thankful for the partnerships we have with our BUSD families. Thank you for all you do to help us make our schools wonderful learning environments for the children of BUSD.
