#### Dear Bellevue Union School District Families and Staff,

The **District English Language Advisory Council (DELAC)** is a committee of parent representatives from each of our four schools: Bellevue Elementary, Kawana Springs Elementary, Meadow View Elementary, and Taylor Mountain Elementary. The main charge of this group is to serve as an advisory team to improve services for our multilingual students learning English as their second language. Our first meeting will be held on *Tuesday, October 25, 2022 from 9:00-10:30 a.m.* at the Learning Center located on the Meadow View Elementary campus. The address is 2641 Dutton Meadow. All are welcome to attend.

Almost one third of the school year is behind us. Our first trimester ends **November 4, 2022**. Soon we will schedule parent conferences where we will discuss your child's progress towards priority standards. If you have any questions about these, you will have an opportunity to discuss these at your *parent/teacher conference the week of November 14-18.* Please note that in order to meet with all parents, this will be a week of early dismissal. Volunteer Opportunities: Please contact your school office directly for current opportunities.

Want to volunteer in the classroom or go on a fieldtrip?

- Bring a negative TB test & Photo ID to the District Office
- Exchange TB test, and ID for fingerprint form (we'll make copies)
- Make appointment to get fingerprints or go to walk in service
- Go to the appointment. Take fingerprint form.
- Wait to be cleared (usually in a matter of days)

Your TB expires after four years and you will need to provide an updated negative TB test to continue volunteering.

As long as you do not make a request to be removed from our volunteer list, your fingerprints will continue to remain active and you will not need to be re-fingerprinted.

#### For BUSD Grade 6 Families

Are you beginning to think about middle school? To check what middle school your child will attend next year, enter your address using this <u>link</u>. If you would like to select a middle school that is different from the one you are assigned to, the window for open enrollment in Santa Rosa City Schools (SRCS) is Oct. 1 - Nov. 15, 2022.

Intra-district applications to attend a different middle school must be completed online with SRCS during that window. Families who need assistance can go to the S.A.F.E. office at 211 Ridgway Avenue. School capacities may restrict availability. See the SRCS district website for more information on intra-district transfer for 7th grade.
