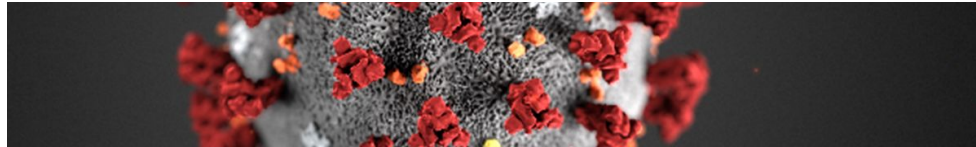

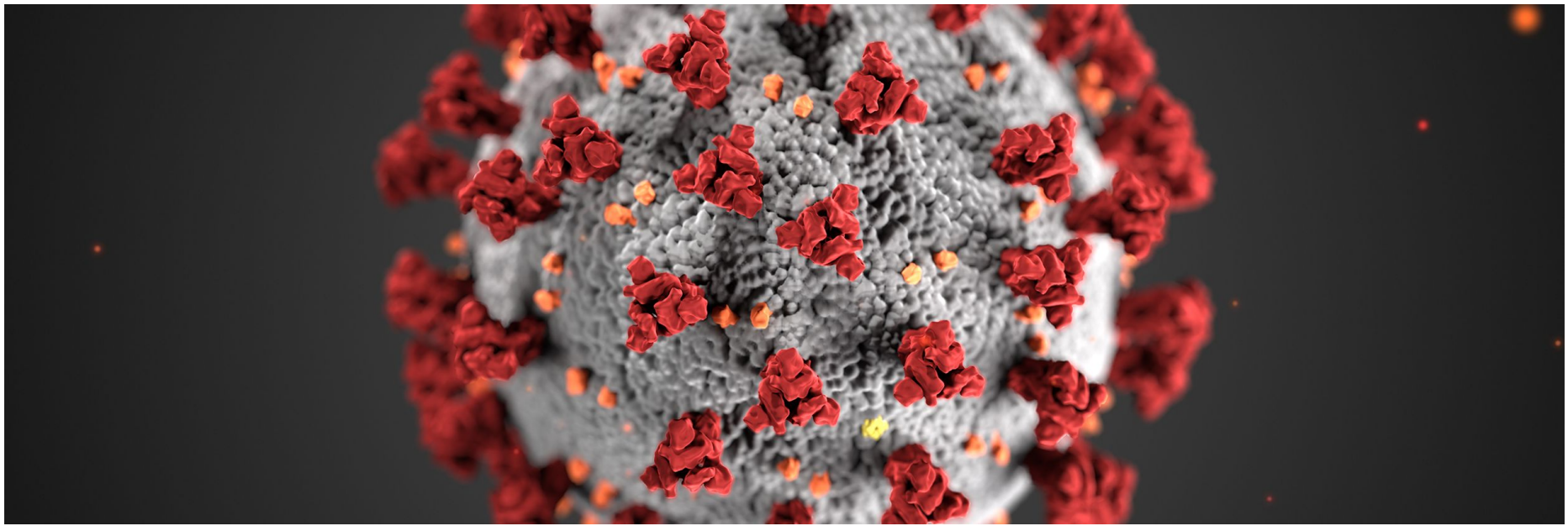

Sonoma County COVID-19 Cases as of 02/16/2021

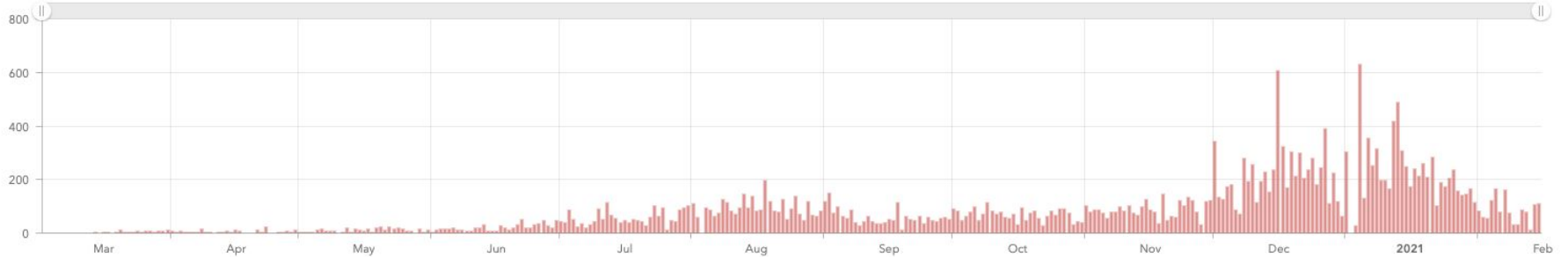

State Indicators, Tiers are listed from Higher Risk to Lower Risk of Community Disease Transmission

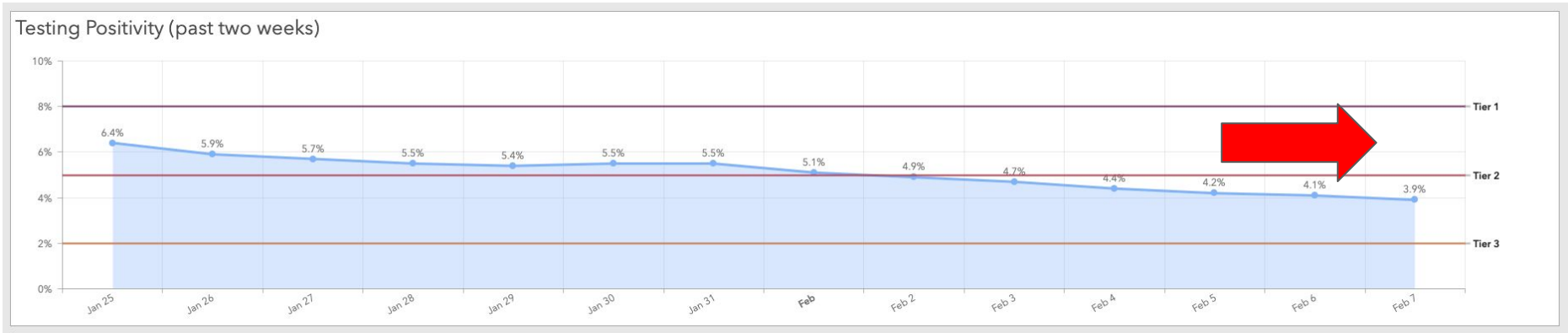
Indicator	Widespread Tier 1	Substantial Tier 2	Moderate Tier 3	Minimal Tier 4
New cases per 100,000 population per day (7 day average; 7 day lag)	> 7	4 – 7	1 – 3.9	< 1
Positive tests percentage (7 day average; 7 day lag)	> 8%	5% – 8%	2% – 4.9%	< 2%

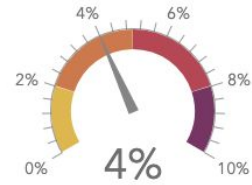
New Cases per 100,000 per day (adjusted for testing volume)

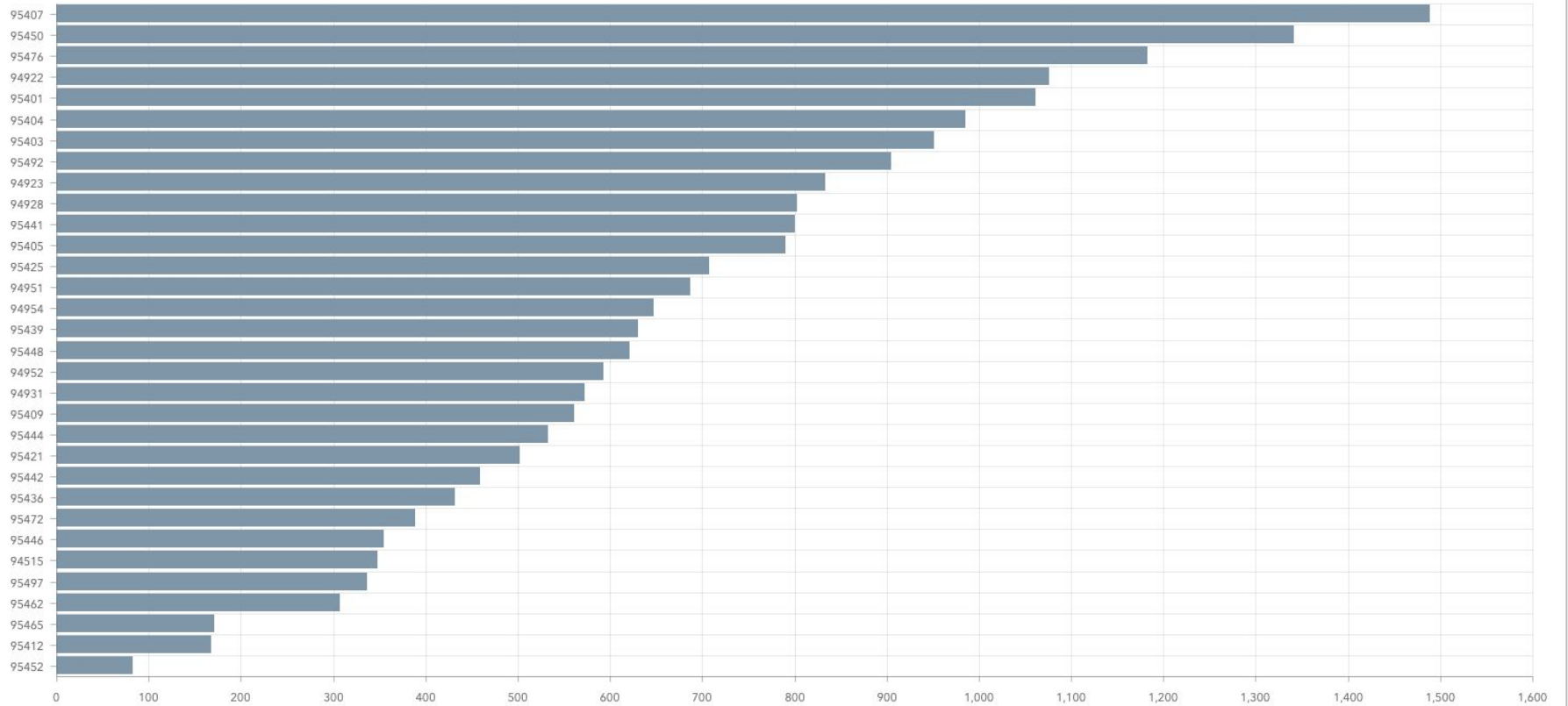

- **95404: Kawana Springs** (Mark West Union School District, Bennett Valley Union School District, Brook Hill Elementary School-SRCS, Proctor Terrace ES-SRCS)
 - Current Active Cases: 398
 - Percentage of Active Cases: 9%
 - Total Cases: 1,933
 - Percentage of Total Cases: 7%

- **95407: Taylor Mountain, Bellevue, & Meadow View** (Roseland School District, Wright School District)
 - Current Active Cases: 582
 - Percentage of Active Cases: 14%
 - Total Cases: 4,340
 - Percentage of Total Cases: 16%

State Criteria to Reopen for In-person

If reopening in purple:

Case Rate average less than 25 per 100,000 residents

5 consecutive days

Covid-19 Safety Plan (CSP) submitted to LHO and State for review & approval. Once approved, CSP must be posted on the website for 5 days prior to reopening.

If reopening in red:

County must be in the Red Tier for 5 consecutive days before school can open for in person instruction

CSP: COVID Prevention Plan (CPP) and COVID-19 Safety Plan Checklist (must be in place) and posted on website 5 days prior to reopening. It is not required that the CSP be submitted for approval.

Vaccine Information

Sonoma County has begun to implement the vaccination plan for school employees. In general, school employees eligible for vaccination during the week of February 15 are limited to:

1. **Cohort A only (BUSD is in Cohort B):** Pre-K-6 staff (of any age) including childcare workers, preschool providers, and K-6 school staff.
2. All school employees age 70 and older regardless of their work assignment
3. Educators who currently have direct contact with students

 - Needs a final revision based on input and the most current information.
 - Town hall meetings
 - Board Approval
- Reopening Negotiations with BEA
- Governor's new plan is coming soon. ???

Considerations

- Safety/Health is #1
 - *Keep on eye on current health/safety status*
- Clear expectations of (students, parents, teachers, staff and leadership):
- Learning Models: Carrying Capacity
 - Classroom space
 - Number of students in each model
 - Staffing
- Survey: Seek parent and staff preferences, once details are clearer
- Staff health accommodations and interactive meetings
- All components are in place
- Staff time to prepare
- Routine testing for staff and students
- Establish Return to School date
