JOB DESCRIPTION Director of Community Education

This position reports to the Superintendent of Schools.

- 1. Plans, organizes and administers a program of enrichment, recreation, adult education and other community education according to community needs.
- 2. Develops, implements and/or modifies regulations and programming in the operation of various community education programs.
- 3. Develops and administers a communications program through various publications and media to inform the community and to promote the opportunities available through the various community education programs.
- 4. Develops community activities in the various schools during after school, evening, weekend, and summer hours.
- 5. Prepares and administers the individual and overall budgets for the various community education programs.
- 6. Responsible for selection and supervision of Community Education licensed and unlicensed coordinators and supervisors.
- 7. Makes recommendations to the Director of Administration and Human Resources on staffing needs and the assignment, promotion, and demotion of personnel.
- 8. Provides in-service opportunities for Community Education staff.
- 9. Establishes an active Community Advisory Council to assist in program development.
- 10. Administers school district pool & arena.
- 11. Administers Board Policy 701 (use of school facilities by community groups), and organizes the development of a yearly and weekly schedule of events for the school district.
- 12. Assists various groups in coordinating activities designated as "community-related".

- 13. Attends and participates in educational meetings, workshops, seminars and conventions.
- 14. Supervises the Family Center.
- 15. Supervises Early Childhood Screening.
- 16. Supervises the Drivers' Education Program.
- 17. Oversees non-school district groups flyer distribution.
- 18. Attends School Board meetings and other meetings as requested by the Superintendent.
- 19. Performs all other acts reasonable and necessary to accomplish the primary function as requested by the Superintendent.
