- 1. The school system should have and encourage numerous organizations within the student body of each building. All of these organizations should have a purpose for existence and should be approved by the administration. The schedule of activities of each organization and the date and time of meetings should be approved by the building principal.
- 2. No student organization may embark on a money-raising venture by selling goods or services to the student body or to adults in the community without receiving the approval of the building principal.
- 3. Each student organization must have at least one faculty advisor. The faculty advisor should be present at all meetings.
