BOMB THREATS 512

1. Most bomb threats in schools are perpetuated as a hoax and result in nothing more than a disruption of school routine. Therefore, it is the policy of this School District that buildings shall not be evacuated as a result of receiving a bomb threat.

- 2. The building principal or designee is responsible for calling the Superintendent or designee and reporting the bomb threat. The administration may contact law enforcement officials.
- 3. The principal will have emergency holding areas arranged for in advance in case an evacuation is ordered.
- 4. Telephone "lock-in" equipment and electronic recorders will be used as appropriate and available, in an attempt to apprehend those individuals who are responsible for making bomb threats in District 831.
- 5. Exceptions to this policy will be at the discretion of the Superintendent or designee.
