

QUALIFICATIONS OF A SCHOOL BUS DRIVER

1. Applicant must be at least 21 years of age.
2. Applicant must be of good moral character.
3. Applicant must meet the physical examination criteria as outlined in the Minnesota Department of Public Safety School Bus Driver's Manual.
4. Applicant must meet the moving violations record standards established by the School District and the Minnesota Department of Public Safety.
5. Applicant must receive at least eight (8) hours classroom training by a certified behind-the-wheel instructor prior to employment.
6. Applicant must possess a current Minnesota Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with School Bus and Passenger endorsements prior to employment. Training is provided.
7. Applicant must authorize the FLASTD to obtain the required criminal background investigations report prior to employment.
8. Applicant must meet other qualifications as noted in the Minnesota School Bus Driver's Handbook.
9. Applicant must pass a drug test in compliance with the Federal Omnibus Employee Testing Act of 1991 and DOT regulations.
10. Applicant must attend all training classes and have current certification in CPR and First Aid.
11. Applicant must complete all other pre-employment criteria as directed.
