QUALIFICATIONS: Prom Court candidates cannot (presently) be on probation or have any academic and behavior violations, suspensions or failing quarter grades for the 2023 year. ELECTIONS: ALL selected candidates will be notified on Tuesday, March 21st. Candidates MUST be approved, attend the mandatory lunch on March 22nd, and pay the non-refundable \$25 campaigning fee before electronic or paper posters can be approved or posted. Prom Court Campaigning will be Monday, April 10th – Friday, April 14th. The Prom Court and winners will be announced at PHS Prom Saturday, April 15th at Crane Bay Event Center. Candidates MUST be present at prom to win.
