Thursday (3/2) <u>Read Across America Day</u>: In honor of Dr. Seuss' Birthday, dress up as your favorite book character.


Friday (3/3) Oh the Places You'll Go: Wear a shirt that represents a place! (college, city or a vacation shirt).








MRS. PELC'S 2ND GRADERS
