Mental Health Awareness Month

May is Mental Health Awareness Month and this is a great time to become more informed of mental health challenges our students may face. Every person has mental health and wellness needs, and the more we are proactive in supporting and recognizing these needs, the better outcomes we all have.

Here in Avon, we care about and support our students' mental wellness by having a guidance counseling staff who are available and able to offer social and emotional support to students as needed. If it is identified that students require more in depth support, we also have a mental wellness program with licensed clinical social workers who can support students through small group sessions. If students and families find that they want more intensive support, Avon schools partner with Cummins Behavioral Health, and students may be eligible for individual services with trained therapists right here in our building during the school day.

While the summer offers students a much deserved break, it is also a time where there may be less structure and routine, causing students to feel off balance. If you are in need of helpful tools to explore mental health and wellness with your student, please look into the website www.mentalhealthishealth.us to search a variety of topics and resources related to coping with and managing challenges they may be facing. Washington, DC— Today, Rep. Victoria Spartz (IN-05) announced the winner of the 2022 Congressional Art Competition. This year's award goes to Jonathan Pyle, a junior at Madison-Grant Jr/Sr High School in Fairmount, IN. His winning piece titled *Indiana Glass Bottles on a Counter* will be on display in the Capitol building in Washington, D.C. for one year, along with the winning artwork from other Congressional districts across the country.

"The talent we have in Indiana's 5th district is impressive, this year's submissions were truly impressive," said Rep. Spartz. "We are thrilled to showcase Jonathan's artwork in Washington, D.C. for all Hoosiers and visitors to enjoy."

The Congressional Art Competition is designed to support the arts and showcase the talent of young artists nationwide. With his artwork, Jonathan highlights the rich history of the glass industry that dates back to 1886 in Howard County. At the time, many glass companies started and flourished in the area due to plentiful access to natural gas.

In addition to the first-place winner, the First Runner Up, 'Sunday', submitted by Emma Cremeans of Avon High School will be displayed in Rep. Spartz's Carmel office. The Second Runner Up 'Comfort Crowd', submitted by Anthony Reyes of Lawrence North High School and will be displayed in the Anderson office.

Related, Rep. Spartz is a cosponsor of H.R. 704, the ARTS Act, a bipartisan piece of legislation that has passed the U.S. House of Representatives and which, if enacted, would direct the Register of Copyrights to waive the copyright registration fee for winners of the Congressional Art Competition and the Congressional App Competition. This would allow student winners to access the benefits of copyright protection for their work.
