GRADES 9 & 10

- Formal Induction takes place at beginning of freshman year at Nichols College, students receive Nichols ID, access to library, sporting events, cultural events.
- Students visit Nichols College several times throughout the year for leadership focused events/ workshops.
- Community Involvement: During grades 9 & 10 students are required to perform a minimum of 10 hours of community service each year. Students are encouraged to participate in at least one extracurricular activity (music, art, sports, etc.) Participation in Academy events through Nichols College is required.
- Academics: In grades 9 & 10 students are encouraged to enroll in honors level or above for all core courses (English, Math, Science, Social Studies).

GRADES 11 & 12

- CONTINUED EMPHASIS ON LEADERSHIP WITH DEEPER DISCUSSION AROUND FUTURE PLANNING AND COLLEGE ADMISSIONS.
- STUDENTS WILL CONTINUE TO HAVE SAME BENEFITS AT NICHOLS AS THE FRESHMEN AND SOPHOMORES.
- STUDENTS ARE ELIGIBLE TO ENROLL IN COLLEGE COURSES THROUGH THE NICHOLS COLLEGE ACCELERATOR PROGRAM AT A DISCOUNTED RATE.

GRADES 11 & 12 CONT.

- COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT: STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO CONTINUE PARTICIPATING IN COMMUNITY SERVICE AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES. CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN ACADEMY EVENTS THROUGH NICHOLS COLLEGE IS REQUIRED.
- ACADEMICS: THROUGHOUT GRADES 11 & 12, ACADEMY STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE 2 HIGHER THAN HONORS LEVEL (COMBINATION OF: AP, NICHOLS ACCELERATOR OR DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES) AND ARE ENCOURAGED TO TAKE HONORS LEVEL IN THEIR OTHER COURSES.
- ACADEMY STUDENTS MUST TAKE THE PSAT AND SAT EXAMS.
