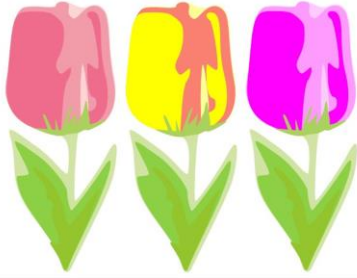

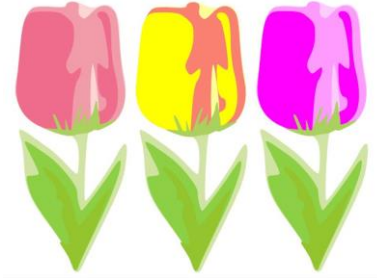

Primary (Grades K-2) 5:00-6:00 PM

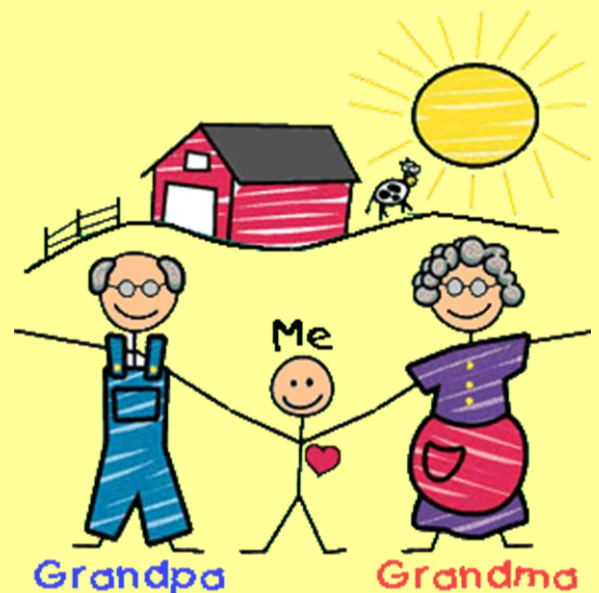
Intermediate (Grades 3-5) 6:15-7:15
