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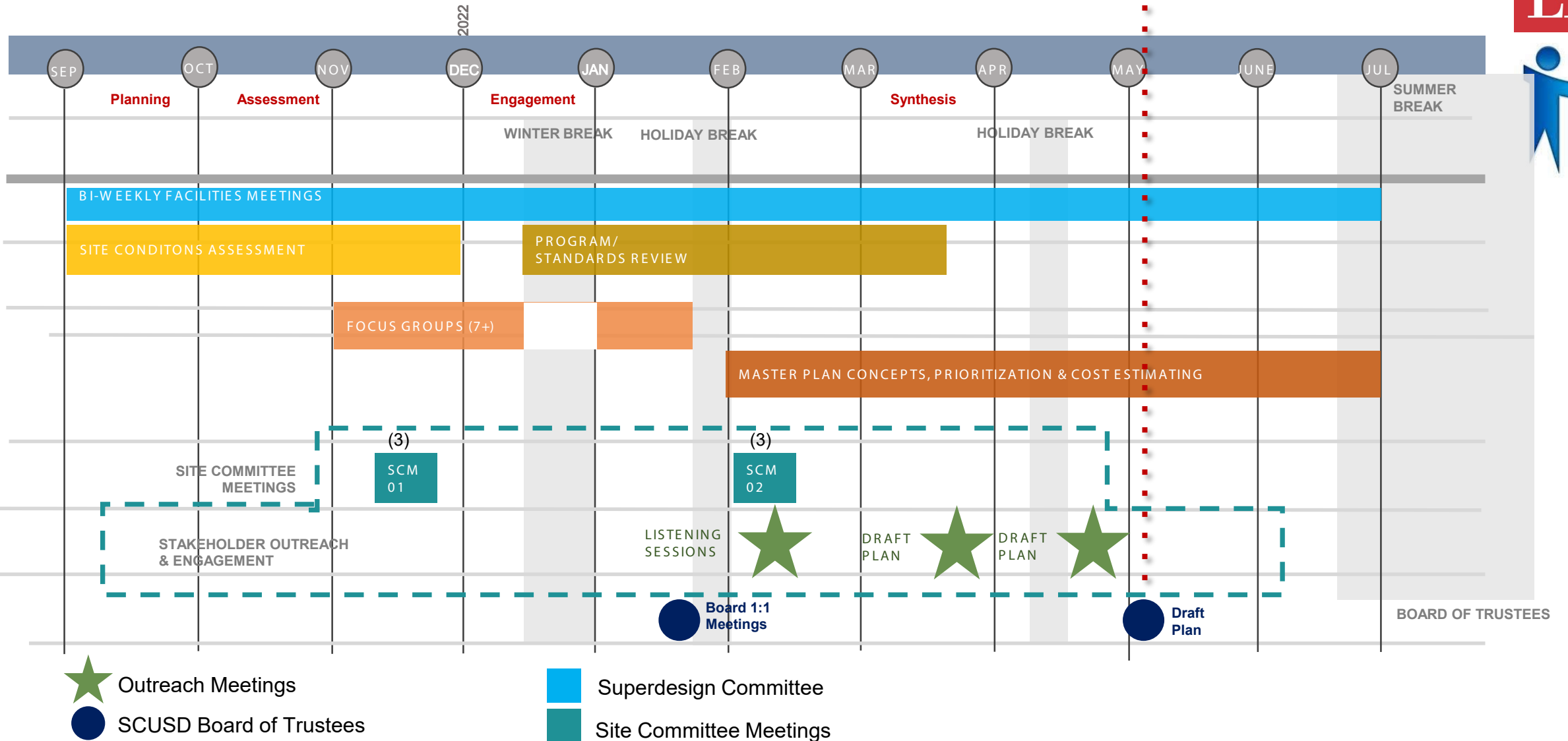

COMMUNITY FEEDBACK Bracher Elementary

- Parking is inefficient and drop off backs up to Bowers
- Make the school more of a community asset & more vibrant to elicit pride
- MPR and Administration spaces are too small and student services spaces are lacking/not adequate
- Remove portables from the campus
- Children's Center facility is inadequate & is separated from rest of campus
- Outdoor learning spaces and gardens
- Specialty classrooms (STEM, art, music)
- Improve fields and hardcourts
- Provide more restrooms (for staff and students)
- More modern/flexible classrooms
- Design a sustainable campus

COMMUNITY FEEDBACK Briarwood Elementary

- Parking and drop off has a pinch point at the entry and exit that affects circulation
- More shade
- Make front of campus more vibrant
- Underutilized space at the front of the school (lawn area)
- Administration building is located well, but too small and poorly laid out
- MPR should function better and have a permanent stage
- Remove portables from the campus
- Outdoor learning spaces and gardens
- Flexible specialty classrooms (STEM, art, music)
- Provide more shade for different functions in hardcourt and play areas

COMMUNITY FEEDBACK Westwood Elementary

- Parking and drop off has issues with the adjacency of Saratoga Ave
- Update the school aesthetics so students are proud of their school
- The campus is full of trees, but not where students can play or utilize the shade. Campus needs more shade for students
- Improve wayfinding & flow – the MPR & Admin not properly located
- Administration and student support spaces are small or lacking
- Remove portables from the campus
- Outdoor learning spaces and gardens
- Flexible specialty classrooms (STEM, art, music)
- A larger MPR that functions better and can be used for many events/uses
- Properly designed hardcourts and field
