

**Strafford R-VI Board of Education**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**March 22, 2018**

President Graves called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Michelle LaFollette came back into the meeting at 7:00 PM.


The Board discussed their attendance at the MSBA Region X meeting on Tuesday, April 24.


The Board came out of executive session at 8:41 PM.

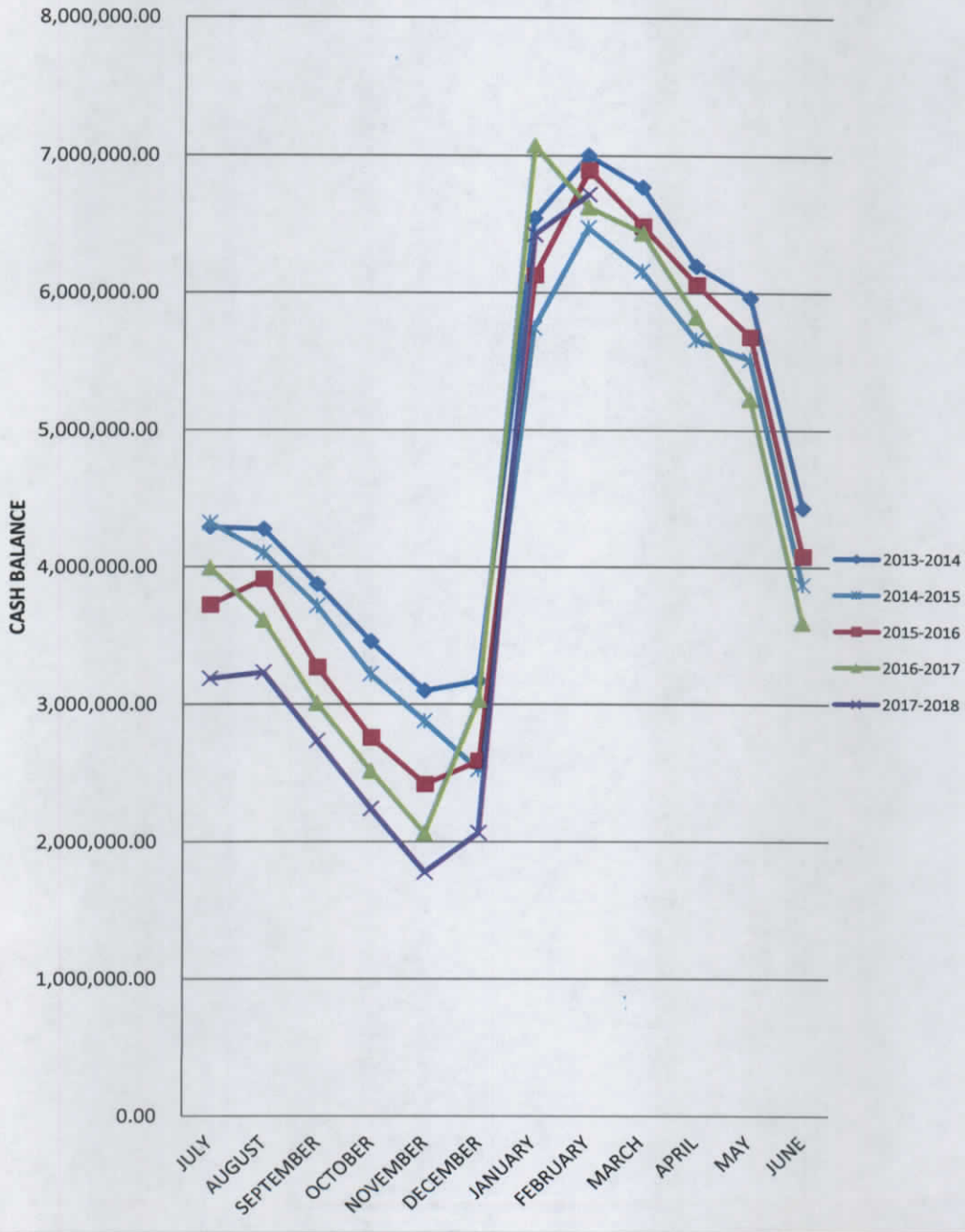
