

**Strafford R-VI Board of Education**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**May 14, 2018**

Bryan Campbell asked for an update on the old elementary classroom renovations.



The Board came out of executive session at 8:30 PM.


The motion was made by Travis Lathrop to approve the administrative and non-certified salaries on the attached list as recommended. Mike Goodin seconded. Carried 7-0.

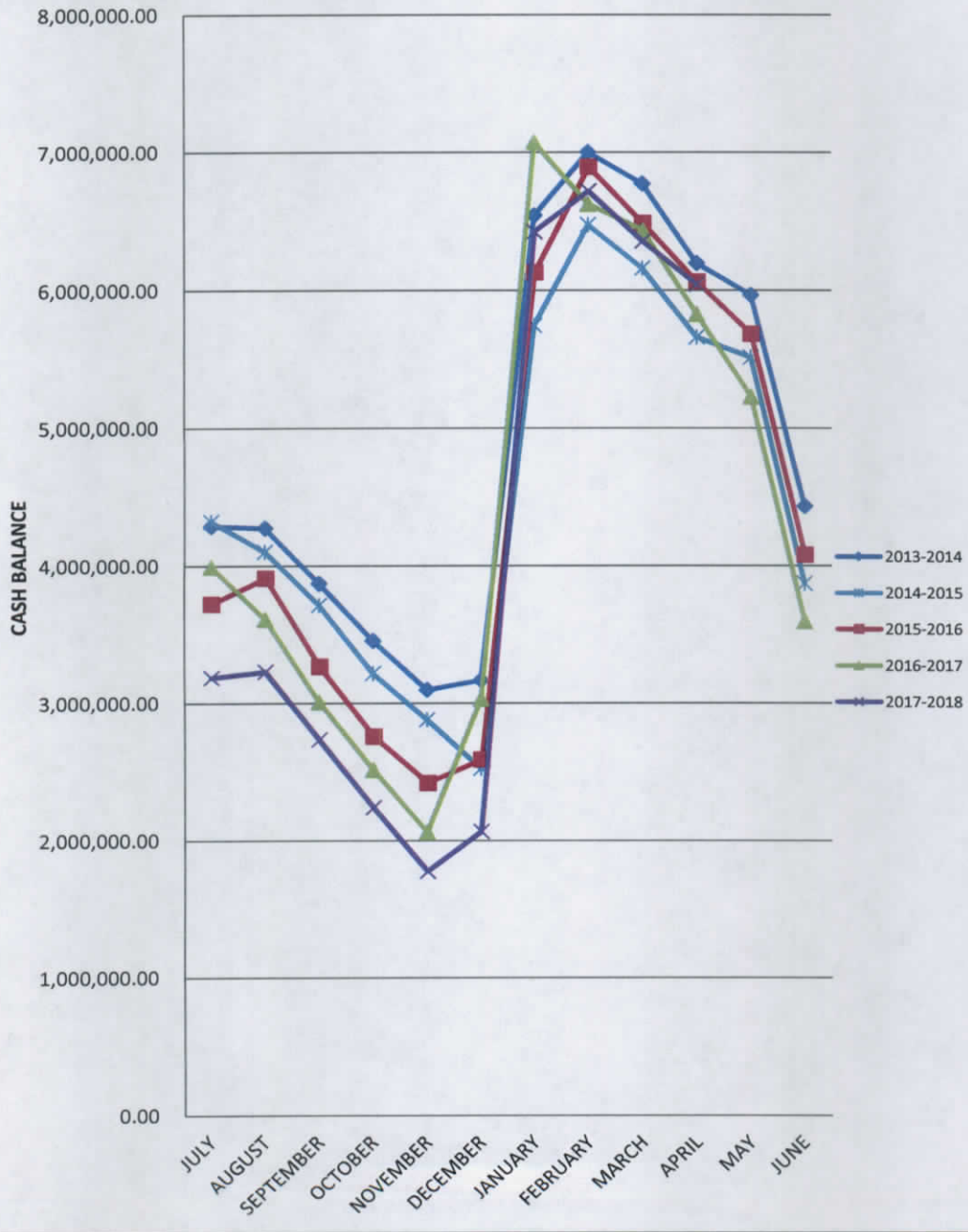
