Bryan Campbell told Vicki Tate it was nice to have her back from her surgery.


Superintendent Soden thanked Michelle LaFollette for making it back in town for the Board meeting to review the salary schedules.

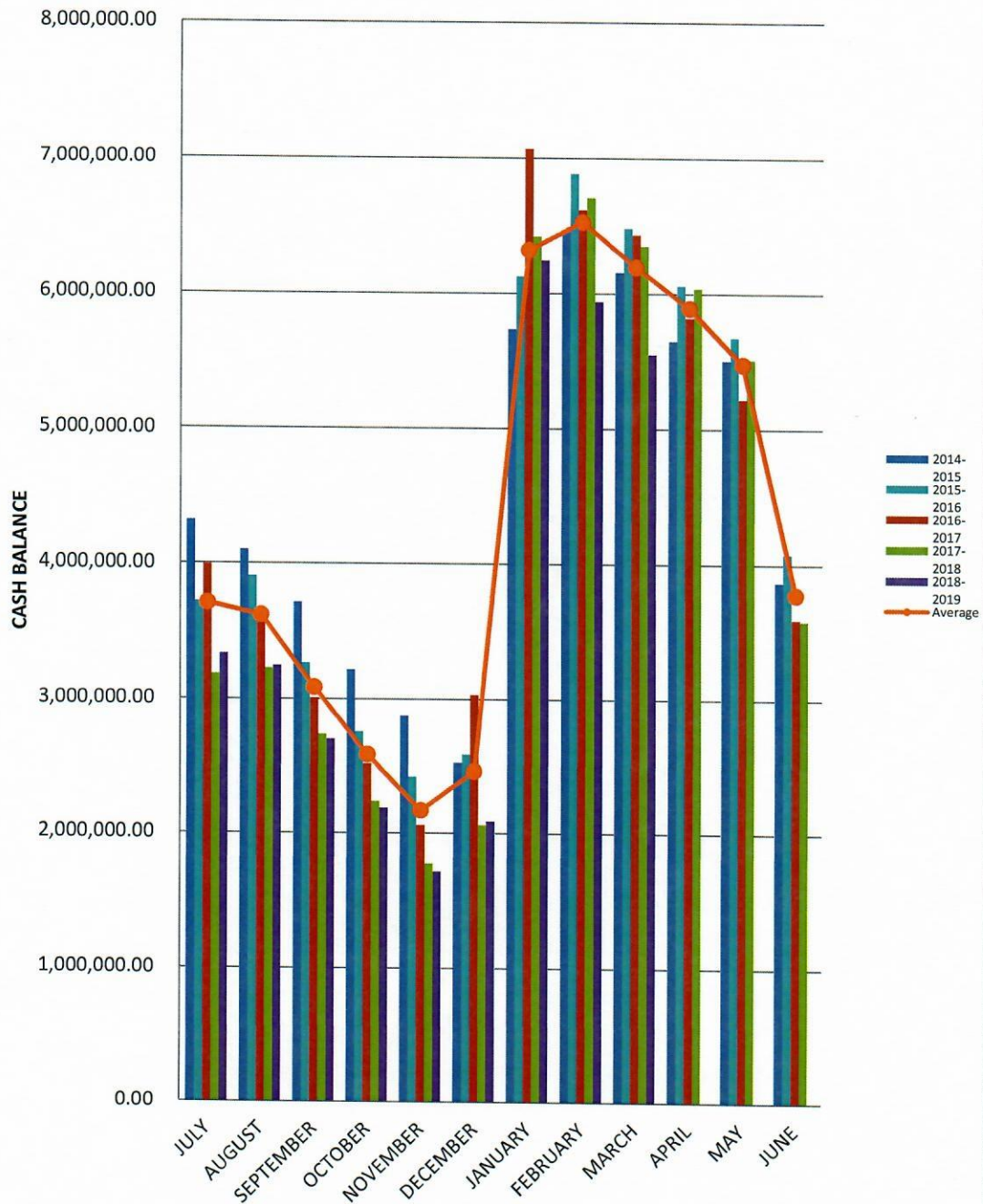

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE INTENT OF STRAFFORD R-VI SCHOOL DISTRICT OF GREENE COUNTY, MISSOURI, TO REIMBURSE ITSELF FOR CERTAIN CAPITAL EXPENDITURES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE STRAFFORD R-VI SCHOOL DISTRICT OF GREENE COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Strafford R-VI School District of Greene County, Missouri (the "District"), expects to make capital expenditures after the date of this Resolution in connection with the construction, equipping, furnishing, renovating and improvement of school buildings (the "Project").

Section 2. The District intends to reimburse itself for such expenditures for the Project from the proceeds of general obligation bonds of the District which were approved by the voters of the District on April 2, 2019, for the purpose of funding the Project.

Section 3. The maximum amount of authorized expenditures for the Project, and the maximum amount of general obligation bonds of the District to be issued to pay for the costs of the Project, will not exceed \$750,000.

Section 4. The Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Education this 25th day of April, 2019.
