The motion was made by Travis Lathrop to approve the March 24, 2021 minutes as presented. Dan MacLachlan seconded. Carried 6-0.

Nancy Dollins read the Greene and Webster County election results.

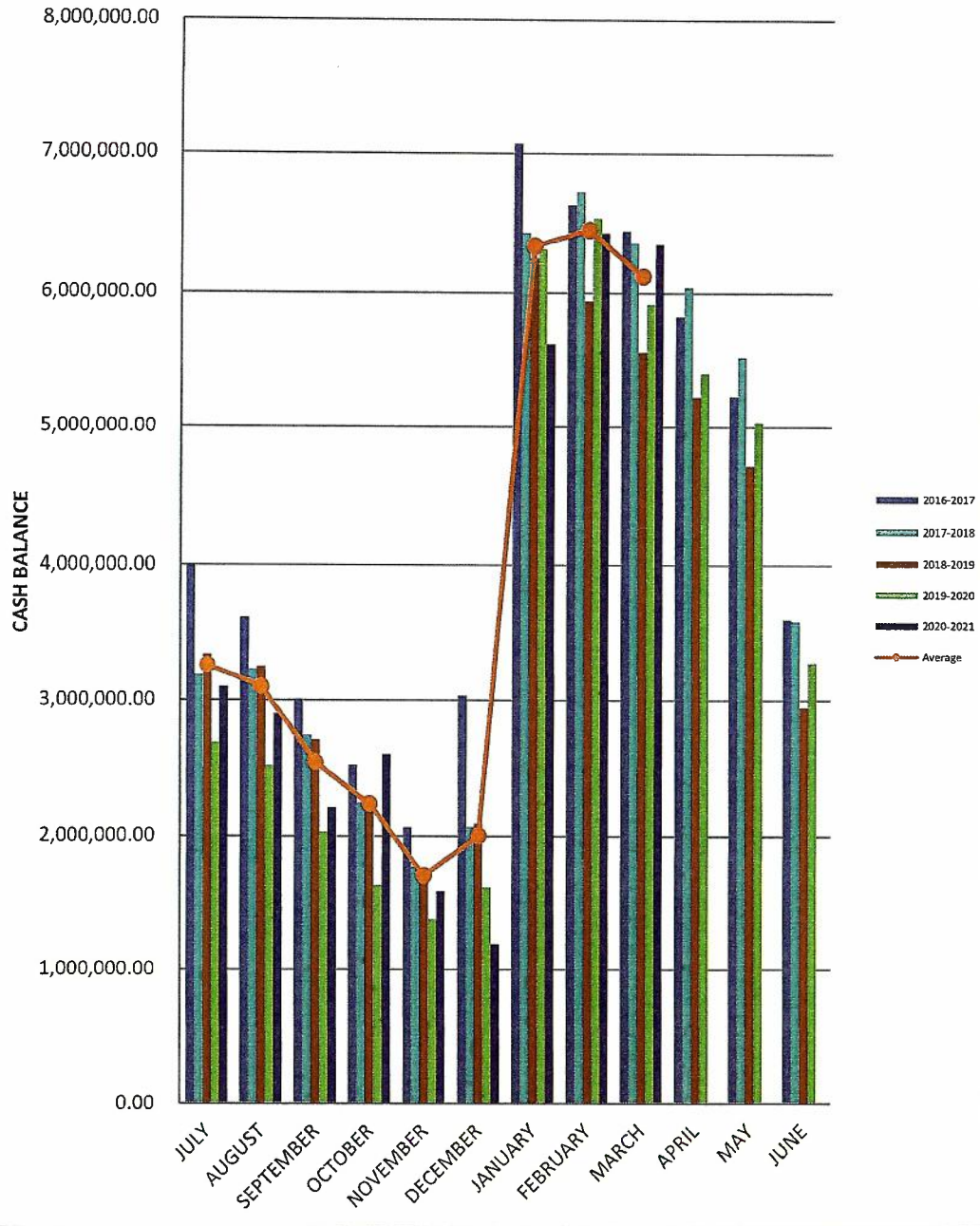
