Millville Area School Board Meeting Minutes

September 11, 2017

The Millville Area School Board held the regular meeting on Monday, September 11, 2017, in the high school library. President Susan Myers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mrs. Jenkins proposed Quaker Connection, a program lead by Jill Bruder, Tarah Kishbach, and Jenna Dyszel. The program is similar to Big Brothers/Big Sisters. High school students would meet with elementary students to act as a role model and form a positive relationship and bond with the elementary students. Both high school and elementary students would need parental permission forms signed before participation. This program would also allow high school students to gain community service credit hours.
